# Race Details

The popular Colgate Road Race has followed the trend for 2020 and will join the growing list of virtual races, with athletes having the option to complete the 32km, 15km or 5km options.

The May 2020 event was forced to be cancelled due to the Covid-19 pandemic and for all 2020 entrants, entry fees will be deferred to the 2021 Colgate Road Race.

The Colgate Virtual Race will offer runners the chance to “compete” over 32km, 15km or 5km distances by measuring their own runs and submitting the timing details to the FinishTime results page.

Finishers must upload their results, either by way of Strava, Garmin Link or manually, to the FinishTime results page before 10am on 19th October 2020. All finishers of all distances will receive a Colgate Medal and T-Shirt.

Medals and T-Shirts can either be collected from Decathlon stores in Boksburg, Alberton, Centurion or Roodepoort, or finishers have the option to have medals posted to them. Postal details must be completed when runners enter on the [Webtickets.co.za](http://Webtickets.co.za) website.

Entry fees for the 32km, 15km or 5km is R80 and entries close on October the 9th.

# Race Rules

## **RULES – 5km / 15km / 32km**

1. This meeting takes place under the rules of the IAAF, ASA, CGA and South African lockdown Level 2 regulations/applicable lockdown level on the day of the race.
2. All entrants will participate under the rules of ASA, CGA and South African lockdown Level 2 regulations; it is the athlete's responsibility to familiarize themselves with the rules and regulations.
3. All the runners participate at their own risk.
4. Athletes must be medically fit to participate, it is the athlete's responsibility to ensure medical fitness prior to participation to this event.
5. No animals / pets are allowed to participate.
6. Runners should obey traffic regulations.
7. The race committee reserves the right to accept or reject any entry.
8. No running with earphones, iPods and the like allowed.
9. Littering is forbidden.
10. Minimum age 5km (9 years) and 10km (14 years).
11. Athletes may run any time between 6am and 10pm on 18 October 2020.
12. Athletes must upload or submit the results before 10am on the 19th October 2020.
13. Colgate and Boksburg Athletic Club are not held liable should any accident, injury or death occur during this event.
