## TAKE NOTE:

Staggered start. Two separate races, one for the 21.1km and a separate race for the 10km with a max of 250 entrants per race.

Strict cut-off times per race will be implemented, runners unable to finish their race within the set race time will be picked up. Walkers especially, take note of the cut-off times (21km: 3 hour cut-off and 10km: 2 hour cut-off)

### ASA Rules apply:

#### REFEREES' DECISION IS FINAL

- Obey all Traffic Officials and Race Marshals.
- All Covid-19 protocols need to be adhered to.
- **60+ will be allowed at this event, but must present a medical clearance letter from GP.**
- The race will be run according to the rules of ASA, WORLD ATHLETICS (WA) & AMPU House rules.
- Ages: Athletes for 10km must be 14 years, 21 km must be 16 years or older on the day of the race.
- Proof of age (ID) to be produced upon request on day of race.
- All athletes participate at their own risk and by entering the event they acknowledge that they are medically fit to participate.
- Registered athletes must wear full club colours.
- 2021 license numbers on the front and back of the vest.
- Temporary license must be fixed on the back of the vest.
- Age category ID tags must be clearly displayed for the duration of the event (back and front) by athletes competing for a category prize AND must be fixed on all 4 corners and not be covered by rain jacket or any Shirt.
- Only athletes with a race number and license numbers will be allowed into event area. Race number must be worn on the front of the vest.
- ASA license numbers must not be covered with any paper race numbers /race bib.
- Walkers competing for Walkers prize must have the "W" fixed on the left front and back of the vest, all 4 corners must be fixed.
- There will be no Prize Giving. Prize money will be transferred electronically.
- No littering, please make use of waste boxes at the start/finish – RUN CLEAN
- All participants must take note that photographs might be taken at the event and placed on social media.
- 12% levy on entry fee must be paid over to Athletics Mpumalanga by race organizer.
- No earphones, iPods and similar devices are allowed, as they are in contravention of the IAAF rule 144.2b and will lead to disqualification
- Only one waterpoint on the route. Circle route No seconding will be allowed.
- **Race numbers will be emailed, please print out and bring it on race day. No race number no entry in the venue**
