Running under the spectacular peaks of the Drakensberg Mountains, the Josiah Gumede Marathon event celebrates the life of Josiah Gumede, the 4th President of the ANC and is one of the cornerstone highlights of the Drakensberg Extravaganza.

REGISTRATION ▶ Registration and the Finish of the race is at the Bergville Sports Centre, Golf Road Bergville. Registration to collect race numbers and race shirts is Friday 26 November 2021, 15h00 to 18h00 and Saturday 27 November 2021, 04h00 – 05h00.

ROUTE & START TIMES ▶ All Routes follow the P288 to Bergville, turn right onto the R74 and left into Golf Road to the Bergville Sports Center.

42km Starts 05h00 at the "Old Aeroplane" at Zwelisha.

21km Starts 06h00 at Dukuza Primary School.

10km Starts 06h30 near the D2101 turn off to Rockdale.

TRANSPORT TO STARTS ▶ Free Taxi transport is provided to the three starts. Taxis leave from the Sports Center from 03h30.

ENTRIES CLOSE 17H00 TUESDAY 23 NOVEMBER 2021

RULES

- Entries close 17h00 on Tuesday 23 November 2021. There are no late entries. **No substitution will be permitted.**
- Race numbers and shirts can be collected at Registration at the Bergville Sports Centre on Friday 26 November 2021 from 15h00 to 18h00 and on Saturday 27 November 2021 from 04h00 to 05h00
- Entrance to the Bergville Sports Centre and Registration will be strictly controlled observing Covid 19 protocols. Every person entering the Bergville Sports Centre will be required to wear a mask, will have their temperature taken and will be required to complete a health questionnaire. Hand sanitising and social distancing will be followed.
- All entrants receive a quality moisture management race shirt. These can be collected at Registration, **the organisers reserve the right to substitute sizes for those requested.**

- All athletes must be licenced. Licenced runners must wear their club colours together with their 2021 licence numbers on the front and back of their upper outer garment and the Josiah Gumede race number on the front of their upper outer garment. The race number must be placed over the licence number so that the province, year and ASA sponsor logo is visible.
- Unlicenced athletes must wear a temporary licence. These athletes must wear plain colour clothing (with no advertising), the temporary licence on the back of their upper outer garment and the Josiah Gumede race number on the front of their upper outer garment. No licence number to be worn on shorts. Temporary licence numbers will be available for collection at Registration. Temporary licences will not be sold at Registration.
- The Josiah Gumede Marathon is held under the rules of Athletics South Africa (ASA) and World Athletics (WA).
- All foreign athletes must comply with WA rule 4.2, rule 22.1 and rule 142 and ASA rule 9.
- Entrants must be at least the following ages on the day of the race:
42KM - 20 Years, 21KM - 16 Years, 10KM - 14 Years
- The ASA/KZNA approved numerical age category tags (60mm – 80mm) must be worn on the back and front of athletes upper outer garment for those competing for category prizes. Proof of age must be provided on request before or after the race.
- A secure tog bag area will be available on the day of the race at the Bergville Sports Centre.
- Athletes are to obey traffic officials, technical officials, Covid 19 compliance staff, event marshalls and safety officers at all times.
- No personal seconding is allowed.
- No blades or wheelchairs or mechanically operated devices are allowed
- No ipods or any other form of earphone type device may be used during the race.
- No pets are allowed in the race.

- Entry fees shall not be refunded, cancelled returned or exchanged on account of weather or unforeseen events occurring beyond the control of the event organisers, the race director, the host club or the sponsors.
- The Josiah Gumede Marathon supports and promotes the clean running campaign. Please help our event and our sport and throw your coke bottles and water sachets in the bins provided.

COVID 19 HEALTH AND SAFETY PROTOCOLS

- All participants must adhere to all COVID 19 Health and Safety protocols implemented by ASA, including the wearing of masks, social distancing, hand sanitizing and must undergo temperature screening before entering the venue.
- A COVID 19 risk assessment form will be sent to all entrants electronically before the race. Where possible entrants must print the form out, complete it and bring it to the venue. Additional forms will be available at registration.
- No form – No entry – No race – No exception.
- No spectators will be allowed.
- Masks must be worn up to the start of the race but not while running. After finishing the race, athletes must again wear their masks and proceed out of the venue
- Athletes must supply their own masks.
