COVID PROTOCOLS AND GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1.A link with your Covid declaration will be sms'd to you 24hrs before the race. This needs to be filled in and returned before race number collection on 29 Jan 2022. For those without the necessary technology, there will be a Covid form to complete at registration.
- 2. Only athletes will be able to access the top level of the Watercrest Mall parking area. No spectators.
- 3. All athletes to wear a mask/buff at the start until the race commences. Masks/buffs to be replaced 20m after finish. Failure to do so could result in disqualification.
- 4. Please adhere to social distancing.
- 5. All athletes to leave the finish area as soon as possible after finishing.
- 6. Please take note of the water tables as noted under Race Rules and Information
- 7. Please endeavour to RUN CLEAN! If extra water sachets are taken beyond the bin areas, please carry the empty sachet to the next table or rubbish bin.

RACE RULES AND INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Age restriction: 19 years and older.
- 2.2021 licence numbers must be worn on front and back of vest/crop top and must be clearly visible.
- 3.Age category tags and walker tags must be worn on front and back of vest/crop top and must be clearly visible. Proof of age will be required for category winners as per ASA rule 2.14
- 4.Results will be posted on the website www.eventtiming.info/pdac
- 5. Cut off is 9:15am. Participants who have not finished by the cut off will be called off the road.
- 6.ER24 ambulance and response vehicle will be available en-route.
- 7.5 water tables provided on a self help basis as per ASA regulations. No open cooldrinks will be offered. Athletes are welcome to carry their own hydration as well as energy bars/drinks. No personal seconding permitted. 8.The race is run in strict accordance with the rules of World Athletics, Athletics South Africa and Kwazulu-Natal
- 9. All foreign athletes must comply with World Athletics Rule 4.2, 22.1 and 142 together with ASA rule 9
- 10. Race officials, marshals and traffic officers MUST be obeyed at all times.
