Prize-giving will take place after race distance of the finish line.

RULES:

- Athletes must be ELIGIBLE members of an affiliated club to qualify as prize winner. You do not need to belong to a club to run any of the races (Adhere to the undermentioned rule 3.)
- Club athletes dressed in club colours must display a year and official ASA 2 licence number on the front and at the back at all times on their vest (year must be 2021/2022).
- Temporary licence numbers to be sold at R70 excluding entry fees to individuals not belonging to a club. This is a must for the different races 42.2 km, 21.1 km and 10 km, excluding the 5 km fun run. The temporary number must be worn on the front of the vest. No insurance coverage.
- Age restrictions: Minimum age 42.2 km – 20 years; 21.1 km – 16 years; 10km – 16 years; 5 km and less – 9 years and older (under supervision of parents.)
- All marshals, traffic authorities and traffic rules must be obeyed. Failing to do so may lead to disqualification.
- Check point on route. (Keep left at all times.) In case of emergencies, report to the next water point, medical station-route and finishing line.
- Evacuation point will be at the starting and finishing point on the Reitz Bowls Club.
- All walkers and runners participate at their own risk. Spectators no gathering at the start and finishing line permitted. Spectators to spread out on the route.
- Due to the nature of the course no wheelchairs, prams, blades, animals, cyclist or mechanically operated devices are allowed, excluding hearing aids.
- No seconding or car will be allowed on the course as there are sufficient refreshment tables. Seconding can only be permitted in the demarcated area of a water point allocated to individuals. Water bottles - participants may make use of one foreseen water bottle filled from start up to finish, being part of the running gear.
- Cut-off time for all races is 12:00. No late starters will be allowed, that is 5 minutes from the group start time. No athletes will be permitted to enter the finishing line after the cut-off time.
- Proof of age must be provided on race day if requested.
- The organisers reserve the right to return any entry not complying to COVID-19 Rules and Regulations. Wearing a mask is compulsory before the start of the race and after finishing it. During the race the wearing of a mask is not compulsory.
- All winners need to attend prize-giving. If not, the athlete needs to inform the chief referee official and LOC chairperson of departure. Results- Due to a non-certified measured route the 21,1km and 10km cannot be used as official results.
- The decision of the organisers will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- Foreign athletes competing for prize money must produce a clearance certificate for their National bodies to compete in SA, handed in to the organisers before the entering.
- Online entries close on 15 February 2022. AFS Green Race - Littering is not allowed. Athletes are to dispose of any litter only in designated litter area. Athletes can be disqualified for littering.
