- > Full compliance with covid 19 regulations.
  - > The race will be staged according to the rules of WA, ASA and KZNA.
  - > 10 km participants must be 14 years or older on the day of the race.
  - > 21.1 km participants must be 16 years or older on the day of the race.
  - > 42.2 km participants must be 20 years or older on the day of the race.
  - > Traffic officers, race officials, marshalls and technical officials to be obeyed at all times.
  - > Foreign athletes must abide by WA rules 4.2, 22.1, 142 and ASA 9
  - > Temp licence holders are not covered by a National Insurance Policy.
  - > No pacing and seconding allowed.
  - > Wear plain clothes when using temp licence. No advertising.
  - > Permanent licence holders to wear club colours.
  - > Age category tags must be worn on the front and the back of the vest/ crop top and must be clearly visible to claim the prize.
  - > 2022 licence numbers to be worn front and back in the upper part of the body. They must be visible.
  - > Proof of age must be produced if requested.
  - > No refunds for entry fees for non participation
  - > Cut off : 2h30, for 10km, 3h30 for 21.1 km and 6 hrs for 42.2km.
  - > Race number must be pinned on the front licence number in such a way that the logo and year of the licence is visible.
  - > Tog bag facility at owner's risk.
  - > All entrants participates at their own risk. Organisers and sponsors will not be held responsible for any loss, injury or any damage during or as a result of the race, property lost or damaged on the course or in the changing areas.
  - > Junior athletes, 19 years and younger on 31 December in the year of the event, must wear a 'j' on the upper front and back of the vest/crop top in order to be eligible for prizes and must provide proof of age on race day.
- Cut off time for 42.2 km
- > Marathon halfway cut off : 3hours.
  - > Any runner who will fail to pass halfway by 3 hours will be asked to leave the road.
