HIPPO MARATHON: RACE RULES AND INFORMATION:

- Number Collection: Friday 25 March from 13:00 - 19:00pm and Saturday 26th March from 3:30am - 4:30am
- Current license number to be worn on front and back of vest
- Tog bag facility will be provided at own risk.
- The race will be run in accordance with the rules of WA, ASA AND KZNA and all participants to abide by these rules.
- All foreign athletes must comply with with WA Rules 4.2, 22.1 and 142 and ASA RULE 9.
- Refreshment stations will be provided along the route and no personal seconding will be permitted
- Marshals, Traffic Officials and technical officials must be obeyed.
- Age Restriction: 42.2km participants must be 20 years or older on race day.
- Age Restriction: 21.1km participants must be 16 years or older on race day.
- Age Restriction: 10km participants must be 14 years or older on race day.
- Proof of age will be required for age category winners.
- ASA/KZNA approved age category tags must be worn on top front and back of vest/croptop to be eligible for age category prizes.
- Walkers: KZNA/ASA approved "W" walker tags must be worn on top front and back of vest/croptop to be eligible for prizes.
- Junior athletes, 19 years or younger on 13 December in the year of the competition must wear "J" on the upper front and back of vest/croptop in order to be eligible for prizes and must provide proof of age on race day.
- ASA LICENCE NUMBERS: Organisers/Athletes may NOT replace license numbers with Competition/Race Numbers/Stickers under any circumstances. Were a Competition/Race number is used, it must be placed so that the ASA License Sponsor and ASA Province/Year remains visible above the Competition/Race number. The License numerals may be covered. Athletes who fail to adhere to this rule may be disqualified. (Refer to ASA 26.1.6 and 26.1.8)
- TEMPORARY LICENSES: Temporary licensed athletes are not covered by a national insurance policy. Refer ASA Rule 25.6.15.
- The rule they must adhere to WA and ASA Rules or ASA Council Meeting to get approval for the change.
- Unregistered athletes running with Temporary licenses must run in neutral colours and adhere to WA and ASA Rules.
- Holders of Temporary licences will be eligible for individual prizes and may claim age category prizes in keeping with WA and ASA Rules and rule 25.5.13.
