The annual Nelson Mandela Bay ASA 21.1km championships will once again be held in Port Elizabeth on Saturday, 4 June 2022, and will incorporate the ASA Half marathon Championships. The event has been awarded World Athletics Elite Label status.

We are proud to showcase Gqeberha during the live broadcast on SuperSport, and trust that you will join us by cheering on the best runners in South Africa as they compete against each other for the National title.

Attached please find the route map and description for your information. Roads will be closed as follows:

4 June 2022

- 03h00 – 11h00 - Full road closure Seaside lanes from Driftsands Drive along Marine Drive to Admiralty way.
- 03h00 – 11h00 - Full road closure Land side lanes from Admiralty Way to 2nd Avenue
- 03h00 – 11h00 - Full road closure Land side lanes from La Roche to Kings Beach
- 07h30 – 09h00 - Full road closure Marine Drive from Admiralty Way to back gate of NMU
- 07h45 – 09h15 - University Way from Gomery Rd to Admiralty Way.
- 07h45 – 09h30 - Admiralty Way from University Way to Marine Drive

Alternative Routes

An alternative route towards Willows/Schoenies via Gomery Road, through NMU and into Marine Drive exiting right, will be available for the duration of the morning.

Alternative route available via Strandfontein road to La Roche.

Between Admiralty Way and 2nd Avenue via Erasmus Street, Skegness Road or Brighton Drive.

Assistance and Exceptions

Vehicles from 2nd Avenue towards Hobie Beach will only be permitted for a short periods of time up to 06h30 and again between 07h55 and 08h10.

Access along Marine Drive between Admiralty Way and the back gate of NMU for vehicles needing to go to Pine Lodge, SANCCOB or the Humewood Golf Club will remain open until 07h45 and will then close until approximately 09h00, after which one lane will be made available for vehicles wishing to turn right into Marine Drive.

Beach Hotel and residents in 1st Avenue will have access via the gate at the back of the Boardwalk.

City Lodge, Brookes Hill and Town Lodge staff and guests will have one lane available towards the City Centre until La Roche Drive.

We envisage to have the majority of the roads to be open by 11h00.

Additional Road Closure

A total road closure of the short section between 8th Avenue and 9th Avenue will be in force from 12h00 on Wednesday, 1 June 2022 until 12h00 on Saturday, 4 June 2022.

We will do our utmost to assist motorists affected and request your co-operation to ensure a pleasant experience for everyone on the day.

It would be highly appreciated if you would inform constituents of the road closure arrangements in place.

Description:

Start in Marine Drive south of bus stop at exit from Pollok Beach. Run northern direction towards town, running with traffic. Continue past 2nd Avenue, Boardwalk, Brookes Hill Drive, La Roche, along S-Bend and turn at robots to return loop to Pollok Beach. Continue along Marine Drive until past Admiralty, still running with traffic. After Admiralty, keep right to run facing traffic until the back gate of NMU. Turn right and continue straight past Stadium, past Langdraai, right at traffic circle through North campus. Exit front gate of NMU North campus and turn right into University Way. Turn right into Admiralty. Continue running facing traffic until after Brighton Drive, cross over to LHS with traffic. Turn left into Marine Drive. Run past the start and follow Northern loop until the finish line, situated past the bus stop after 8th Avenue.
