- 1. Relevant Covid-19 restrictions will apply.
- Athletes must run in official club colours with 2022 licence numbers on the front and back of the vest and official race number on the front of the vest.
- Athletes who are not licensed members of a club affiliated to ASA
 must purchase a temporary license to be worn on the back of vest or
 plain coloured T-shirt, with the official race number on the front of the
 vest/T-shirt.
- Temporary licenced athletes are not covered by ASA group insurance and are encouraged to join an athletics clubs
- Age category tags must be worn on front and back of your vest if you wish to qualify for category prizes.
- 6. Prize winners may be requested to provide proof of age.
- 7. Wearing of earphones are not allowed and may lead to disqualification.
- 8. The race committee reserves the right to accept or reject any entry.
- 9. The Prize Giving will commence at 09h00.
- Entries may be handed in at Brian Bands, The Footballer, Action Sports or UD Sport in Uitenhage. The closing date for pre-entries will be Wednesday 22 June 2022. Online entries are available on www.webtickets.co.za and will close on Tuesday 21 June 2022. Full results will also be posted on www.epathletics.co.za.
- 11. No Alcohol may be brought onto the premises.
- 12. Collection of race numbers (pre-entries) will be available at the Westbourne Oval on Friday 24 June between 14h00 and 18h00. Late entries will also be available.
