# RULES

- Staged subject to the rules of WA, ASA, and KZNA and participants to abide by these rules.
- The 2022 licence number must be worn on the front and back of vest/crop top (ASA Rule 25.4.8).
- ASA approved age category tags must be worn on upper front and back of vest/crop top to be eligible for age category prizes (ASA Rule 22.9).
- Walkers must wear KZNA approved "W" tags on the upper front and back of vest/crop top (ASA Rule 33.1).
- Junior athletes (19 years or younger on 31 December in the year of competition) must wear a "J" tag on the upper front and back of vest/crop top in order to be eligible for prizes and must provide proof of age on race day.
- Temp licences must be worn on the back of the vest/crop top with the race number on the front.
- Temp licenced runners to wear neutral colours and adhere to WA and ASA Rules.
- Temp licenced athletes are not covered by a National Insurance Policy (ASA Rule 25.6.15)
- Open to all runners/walkers aged 15 years and older on race day.

- Foreign athletes must comply with WA Rules 4.2, 22.1 and 142 and ASA Rule 9.
- Any athlete wishing to count towards a team prize must have a permanent licence and must wear full club colours (ASA Rule 24.10).
- Holders of temp licences will be eligible for individual prizes and may claim age category prizes in keeping with WA and ASA Rule 25.6.13.
- Proof of age required for age category winners (ASA Rule 2.14).
- Traffic Officers, Marshals, and Race Officials must be obeyed.
- Refreshment stations will be provided along the route and no personal seconding will be allowed.
- Tog bag facility will be provided but at owner's risk.
- ASA Licence Numbers: Organisers/athletes may NOT replace ASA licence numbers with competition/race numbers under any circumstances. Where a competition/race number is used, it must be placed so that the ASA licence sponsor and the ASA province/year remains visible above the competition/race number. The licence numerals may be covered. Athletes who fail to adhere to this rule may be disqualified (ASA Rule 26.1.7).

All club tents must be erected on Saturday, 10 December 2022. No vehicle access to the grounds on Sunday (race day).
