RULES

- The race is run according to the rules of ASA and WPA.
- 2. Participants in the 10K run must be 14 years of age or older on race day.
- Race numbers (bibs) will not be issued.
 All registered athletes must wear two valid licence numbers. Unregistered participants must purchase a Temporary Licence which must be worn on the front of the vest.
- Temporary licence holders when registering must complete and hand in the tear off strip from the number in order to be eligible to compete.
- Temporary licenced athletes must run in clothing without advertising.
- Age category tags must be worn (front and back) and visible for the entire race to be eligible for any age category prize including Juniors.
- In 2022 Juniors are defined as anyone born in 2003 or later. (Under the age of 20 at year end).
- To qualify for team prizes, athletes must wear full club colours and participate with a permanent licence.

- Entry cards must be in the athlete's possession during the race and handed in at the results board at the Finish.
- There will be two water stations with water sachets and Coca-Cola/water at the finish.
- Do not litter. Dispose of sachets and cups responsibly by using the boxes provided or carrying them to the Finish Report offenders to the referees. #RunClean.
- 12. The use of music players with headphones is not allowed and may result in disqualification.
- Runners to obey traffic officers, race marshals, officials, and Safety Officers at all times

- Wheelchair athletes must please contact the organisers timeously to discuss arrangements for their participation.
