RULES

- Participants must wear 2022 ASA LICENSES on the back and front of their vests/tops.**
- Temporary license numbers must be worn on front of vests/tops.**
- Age flashes must be worn on the front and back of vest or crop top to qualify for prizes in age categories
- COVID-19 Protocols must be adhered to at all times.
- No earphones allowed and offenders will be disqualified. Only hearing aids will be accepted.
- Refreshments tables are provided every 3km along the route.
- The race is under the rules and regulations of WA, ASA & Border Athletics. Non-adherence will result in disqualification.
