RACE RULES AND INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Age restriction: 19 years and older.
- 2.2022/2023 licence numbers must be worn on front and back of vest/crop top and must be clearly visible.
- 3. Age category tags and walker tags must be worn on front and back of vest/crop top and must be clearly visible. Proof of age will be required for category winners as per ASA rule 2.14
- 4. Results will be posted on the website www.eventtiming.info/pdac
- 5. Cut off is 9:15am. Participants who have not finished by the cut off will be called off the road.
- ER24 ambulance and response vehicle will be available en-route.
- 7. There will be 6 refreshment stations offering water sachets and coke. No personal seconding permitted. Please endeavour to RUN CLEAN. If extra water sachets are taken beyond the bin area, please carry the empty sachet to the next table or rubbish bin.
- 8. The race is run in strict accordance with the rules of World Athletics, Athletics South Africa and Kwazulu-Natal
- 9. All foreign athletes must comply with World Athletics Rule 4.2, 22.1 and 142 together with ASA rule 9
- 10. Race officials, marshals and traffic officers MUST be obeyed at all times.
