- Races will start and finish at the Stedin College, Victoria Drive, Walmer, Gqeberha. 21.1km-06h30 and 10km-06h35 on Saturday 12 August 2023.
- 4. Prize giving and Lucky Draws will take place at 09h30. You need to be present to win
- Athletes must run in official club colours with 2023 license number on the front and back of the vest. If race number is supplied, it should be placed over the front licence number with ASA sponsors visible.
- 6. Temporary licenced for 21.1 & 10km will be on sale at R40.00 for athletes who are not licenced members of a club affiliated to ASA. It must be worn on the front of your vest/shirt.
