
#### GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1. Start/Finish on premises of St Albans Correctional Services Rugby Field.
- 2. Starting times: **10km 07h00**
- 3. Race entries may be collected/ handed in at Brian Bands (Cape Road), Utenhage at UD Sports, and Sportmans Warehouse. Closing date for all pre-entries on Wednesday 22 March 2023 16:30):
- 4. A receipt slip may be required in the case of any discrepancy with pre-entries.
- Collection of race numbers (pre-entries) and late entries will be accepted from 14h00 until 18h00 on Friday 24 March 2023 at EPA offices and the morning of the race from 04h30 till 06h30 at St Albans Correctional Services Rugby field.All entries non- refundable.
- 6. Cut of time: 100 minutes (08:40).
- 7. Lucky draw prizes available at finishing line.
- 8. The minimum age for 10km is 14yrs on race day.
- 9. All runners run on the righthand side of the road, facing traffic.
- 10. All traffic officers & marshals shall be obeyed at all times.
- 11. Parking available at St Albans Correctional Services Rugby Field. Please do park at the designated parking area.
- 12. Athletes must run in official club colours with 2023 licence numbers on the front and back of the vest.
- 13. Unlicensed athletes in the 10km must purchase a temporary licence to be worn on the front of vest or a plain T-shirt.
- 14. Temporary licensed runners are not covered by ASA Insurance Scheme. Completion of the tear-off strip is compulsory. Temporary licenced runners are urged to join an affiliated club. Contact EPA for more information.041-374 2818
- 15. Race held under rules of ASA and EPA. Athletes indemnify the provincial & Regional Bodies, sponsors or Organisers against all & any action of whatsoever nature, arising out of their participation in the race.
- 16. Age category tags must be worn on front and back of your vest to be eligible for category prizes on race day and must be clearly visible.
- 17. There will be two refreshments stations on the 10 km route. Refuse bins will be provided up to 500m after the refreshment stations along the route. Please discard litter into these bins and not beyond the designated point. Intentional littering may lead to disqualification.
- 18. The no seconding rule will apply.
- 19. The wearing of earphones & headsets is not permitted due to safety reasons and will lead to disqualification.
- 20. Race Organisers reserve the right to accept or reject any entry.
- 21. Gatherings are allowed before and after the race event. Gazebos allowed.
