#### Race Rules

42.2km and 21.1km start at 06:00 10km and 5km. run start at 06:15

- 1. Race under the rules of WA, ASA and AVT.
- 2. Age restriction:
- 42.2km and 21.1 km: The participant must be 16 years or older on race day.
- 10 km: The participant must be 14 years or older on race day.
- **3. All foreign** athletes must abide by WA rules 4.2, 22.1 and 142 ASA rule 9.
- **4. ASA/AVT approved** age tags to be worn on upper front and back of vest/crop top, to be eligible for age category prizes.
- **5. 2023 license number** must be worn on the back and front of vest.
- **6.** The race number must be worn over the permanent license number on the front of the upper body clothing and be placed so that the ASA province year remain visible above the race number (ASA Rule 26.1), Temporary license athletes must wear the race number on the front upper body clothing.
- **7. Race numbers** and license numbers must not be worn on shorts/tights.
- 8. Temporary license must be worn on back of vest and the completed tear-off slip must be lodged with the organizers at the end of the race

#### 9. Cut-off times:

42.2 km: 6 hours 21.1 km: 3hrs 30 min 10 km: 2hr 00 min

- **10. Results** will be sent via sms and Finish Time website **www.finishtime.co.za**
- **11. Disqualified athletes** will not be eligible for any incentives/giveaways
- 12. Participants must obey the race officials, marshals and traffic officers.
- 13. Entry fee is non-refundable.
- **14. Prize money** only for the race you enter.
- **15. Refreshment** stations every 3 km and no personal seconding will be allowed.
- 16. All participants to abide by the rules and regulations of the event. You participate in the event at own risk and hereby indemnify the national and provincial bodies, sponsors and organizers of the race against any action or claim of whatever nature, which may result from my participation in the event.
