- Race numbers can be collected from the Cillie High school JJ Engelbrecht Sport Fields, c/o Sydenham Road and Ambrose Street, North End on Friday 4 August between 14h00 and 18h00, and from 06h00 on the morning of the race. Late entries will also be available during this time.
- Collection of numbers and late entries will also be available on the morning of the race at the race venue between 06h00 and 07h00.
- Race held under the Rules of ASA and EPA. All athletes indemnify the National, Provincial and Regional Bodies, the Sponsors and the Organizers against all and any actions of whatsoever nature.
- Official 2023 license numbers to be worn on front and back of vest with the official race number on the front.
- Temporary license holders must wear a plain T-shirt or vest and display the license on the back of the T-shirt or vest with the official race number on the front.
- Temporary licensed athletes are not covered by ASA Insurance scheme and are encouraged to join an athletics club.
- Age category tags to be worn to qualify for age category prizes.
- · Prize winners may be requested to provide proof of age.
- Entrants MUST be 14 years or older on the day of the race.
- Cut off time 100 minutes.
- There will be water stations along the route, no personal seconding.
- Anti-litter campaign: Make use of the refuse bins along side the route.
- DO NOT DROP YOUR SACHETS on the ground. USE THE BINS.
- Littering outside the designated areas could lead to disqualification.
- Race officials and marshals are to be obeyed at all times.
- All runners run on the right-hand side of the road unless otherwise instructed by a marshall.
- Toilet facilities are available at the Start / Finish.

- The wearing of earphones may lead to disqualification.
