- 1. Entries: Online at www.racetraq.co.za (should you have any enquiries about entering online,
- please contact web-query@racetraq.co.za) online entries open Saturday 1st of July and the closing date for on-line entries, is midnight on Wednesday 2th August 2023. On-line entries include a service charge. Late entries and registration will be available at the Martello Sports Field on the race day from 05:00am - 06:45am.
- Late entries will be accepted at the collection points. 'Late card payments will incur additional fees of R5 for licensed runners and R7 for unlicensed runners.'
- 3. Start: The race starts at 07H00 from Naval Base Sports Field Martello Road.
- 4. Age Limit: The minimum age on the day of the race for participants is 19 years or older.
- 5. Cut off: 4 hours 30 minutes at 11H30.
- 6. Prize Giving will commence at cut off time, there will be Spot prizes for grabs.
- 7. Participants must obey instructions of Marshalls, Race Officials and Traffic Officers.
- 8. Entry cards must be in the athlete's possession during the race and handed in at the results board at the finish.
- 9. Licensed Athletes must wear 2023 Licences on the front and back of the vest.
- 10. Unlicensed Athletes must buy a 2023 Temporary Licence and display it on the front of the vest.
