RULES AND INFORMATION - 15km

1. Prize giving will start at 08:00
2. Cut off time of 2 hours 30 minutes. (08:30)
3. Marshalls, traffic officials and traffic rules must be obeyed at all times. Failure to comply with any official may lead to immediate disqualification.
4. Prizes will ONLY be awarded to athletes who have filled in all details on the tear off strip. (Athletes that pre-entered are responsible for filling in all details on race number tear off strip.)
5. No refunds will be entered into.
6. In the event of non-participation an entrant may not allow another runner to use his/her number without prior permission from the race organiser, which permission must be obtained at least 24 hours in advance.
7. Secure parking and tog bag area available. PLEASE NOTE whilst best care will be taken at the tog bag and parking areas, Boksburg Athletic Club and their sponsors will NOT be held liable for any losses.
8. Race results available at +/-3 weeks after race day on www.raceresults.co.za.
9. On line entries to be collected on race day ONLY at ON-LINE ENTRY TABLE. (Entrants MUST BRING a copy of entry and proof of payment as proof).
10. Ample secure parking. Four water points along the route.
11. This meeting takes place under the rules of the IAAF, ASA and CGA.
12. Athletes indemnify the national, provincial and regional bodies, sponsors and organizers of the race against any or all actions of whatsoever nature, whatever the same may arise out of their participation in the race.
13. All athletes participate at their own risk. Athletes acknowledge by entering the event that they are medically fit to participate. All athletes must supply the name and contact number of their next of kin on both the race number and entry form. Objections fee must be lodged within 30 minutes before or after prize-giving in writing to the chief referee, accompanied by a deposit of R500.00, which is refundable if the appeal is upheld.
14. Licensed athletes must wear club colours and their 2023 license number back and front, with the race number worn on the front of vest.
15. Licensed athletes who do not wear their 2023 license numbers must purchase a temporary license on the day or face disqualification.
16. Temporary licensed athletes to wear plain clothing with the issued temporary license on the back of their vest. No temp licenses are issued for marathons or ultra marathons.
17. Athletes competing for category prizes must wear clearly visible age tags of the appropriate size, on the back and front of their running vest.
18. No seconding allowed.
19. Foreign athletes must provide a valid clearance certificate (from their country of origin and ASA) well as a copy of their passport to the organizers and chief referee prior to the start of the event or on demand. Foreign athletes are not allowed to run with an ASA Provincial license. They are required to purchase a temporary license or face disqualification. Foreign athletes are not allowed to run in club colours (neutral kit must be worn) unless such club exists in their country of origin or they are in possession of a refugee status permit or are naturalised citizens of RSA. (Refer to IAAF rule 4). Prizes will be withheld if this rule is not adhered to.
20. Walkers competing for Walkers' prizes (if any) must wear Walker tags on the front and back of their running vest.
21. No blades, bicycles or mechanically operated devices allowed in the race.
22. No 2, 3 or 4 wheel carts/prams which are mechanically or manually operated by participants, or wheelchair athletes will be permitted to participate without special permission having been granted by the race organiser. All such participants MUST start the back of the field.
23. No animals/pets are allowed to participate.
24. Only South African athletes are eligible for team prizes. The domicile rule applies.
25. All instructions from traffic, race and technical officials must be obeyed at all times.
26. Proof of age for prize winners is required and must be presented to the referees before prize giving. Prizes will be withheld until all the necessary details of the winners are confirmed.
27. Only those who have completed all the information required on the race entry/number are eligible for prizes.
28. No earphones, iPods and the like allowed and contravention of IAAF rule 144.2b, may lead to disqualification.
29. The race organiser retains the right to refuse entry and eject persons under the influence of drugs or alcohol, who are disorderly, or engage in inappropriate behaviour, vandalism or evade paying for admission.
30. Athletes who participate without buying a race entry will be disqualified, will not be entitled to any benefits associated with the race and will be liable for a double entry fee charge. Habitual offenders (those who regularly participate without purchasing a race entry) will be called to a CGA disciplinary.
31. Licensed athletes not wearing club colours may face disqualification.
32. Littering is not allowed. Athletes are to dispose of any litter in appropriate bins. Athletes can be disqualified if they litter.
33. Minimum age for 15km is 16 years.
34. Children are required to be under adult supervision at all times.

RULES AND INFORMATION - 5km Fun Run/Walk

1. Walkers welcome. (Cut off 90 minutes)
2. Regret no wheelchair athletes allowed. No blade, bicycles or mechanically operated devices allowed. Prams and strollers allowed in the 5km Fun Run only.
3. Marshalls, traffic officials and traffic rules to be obeyed at all times. Failure to comply with any official may lead to immediate disqualification.
4. Participants indemnify the national, provincial and regional bodies, sponsors and organisers of the fun run against all and any action of whatsoever nature, whatever the same may be arising out of their participation in the fun run.
5. No musical ear pieces are allowed to be worn.
6. No age restriction applies for the 5km, but parents entering children take full responsibility for the safety of their children.
7. No licence numbers are required for the 5km fun run.
8. Athletes participate at their own risk.
9. Regrettably no animals allowed.
