#### **MALE & FEMALE**

#### **Race Rules and Information:**

- 1. Race held in accordance with WA, ASA and KZNA Rules
- 2. All Provinces are required to enter athletes based on the respective individual provincial qualify times and standards
- 3. The licence number may be covered with the competition issued number
- 4. Both provincial licenses MUST be worn on the upper part of the vest/crop top (front and back)
- 5. Please bring proof of payment when collecting race number
- 6. Tog bag facilities will be provided use of them is at participant's own risk (race officials/organizers are not liable for loss of personal belongings)
- 7. All relevant age categories must be clearly visible
- 8. No refunds
- 9. No pacing permitted
- 10. No seconding or vehicles will be allowed on the route
- 11. Club kit to be worn
- 12. Participants must obey Marshalls, traffic officials, and race officials
- 13. All foreign/international athletes must comply with WA Competition Rule 1.7 and ASA rule 9
- 14. All international athletes to buy and wear temporary licences at the back of their race shirts and race number on the front, failure to do so will result in automatic disqualification
- 15. 10km participants must be from 14 years of age/21.1km participants must be from 16 years of age / 42.2km participants must be from 20 years of age and above.
- 16. Regret no wheelchair athletes, blade, cyclist or mechanically operated device allowed in the races.
- 17. No animals are allowed in the races.
- 18. Dispose your water sachets in the recycling bins at the refreshment stations. (See also ASA Rule 28)
- 19. Refreshment statements (+3km) will provide Coke and water sachets. Do your bit to ensure that the race is litter free.
- 20. The route measurement is KZNA, ASA & WA certified as required for official record purposes and should any records be broken on race day.
- 21. Only athletes who are of age 19 years and younger on the 31st December 2023 are eligible for a junior prize
- 22. Proof of ID required for prize giving
- 23. All prize winners must be present at the prize giving ceremony, failure to attend prize giving ceremony will result in forfeiture of prize money
- 24. Should the race be selected by South African Institute for Drug-Free Sport (SAIDS) then prize money will only be provided upon receipt of the results.
