- 2. Participants in the 10K run must be 14 years of age or older on race day.
- Race numbers (bibs) will not be issued. All registered athletes must wear two valid licence numbers. Unregistered participants must purchase a Temporary Licence which must be worn on the front of the vest.
- 4. Temporary licence holders when registering must complete and hand in the tear off strip from the number to be eligible to compete.
- 5. Licenced athletes should wear club colours. Full club colours must be worn to qualify for team prizes. Temporary licenced athletes must run in clothing without advertising.
- Age category tags must be worn (front and back) and be visible for the entire race to be eligible for any age category prize including Juniors.
- In 2023 Juniors are defined as anyone born in 2004 or later (Under the age of 20 at year end).

- 8. Entry cards must be in the athlete's possession during the race and handed in at the results board at the Finish to qualify for spot prizes.
