- 3. The strip is to prevent water and body fluids from affecting the chip signal. Please do not bend or fold your race number for this could affect the antennae and also the signal capability of the chip.

## RACE RULES

- 1. The Safari Half Marathon is run in accordance with the rules of ASA and Boland Athletics.
  2. The Safari 21.1km and 10km is open to all licenced and non-licenced runners of 14 years and older for the 10km and 16 years and older for
- 1. Ikm.

  3. Licenced runners should wear club colours. Official event race number to be worn on the front. Registered athletes must wear their ASA licences on the front and back of their vest. The race number must be worn on the front of the vest, partially covering the ASA licence, so that the ASA licence sponsor remains visible. Temporary licenced runners must wear the race number on the front of their vest and the temporary licence on the back.

  4. Temporary licences are available at R40 for the 21.1km and 10km events.

  5. Temporary licenced participants are eligible for age category prizes provided they enter the relevant age group, wear the appropriate age tags and

- 6. Unlicensed runners must wear plain clothes (no advertising permitted). Official event race number to be worn on the front and the temporary licence
- 7. Personal seconding is not permitted. Private vehicles are requested not to follow the athletes on the route.8. In addition to overall (Open) prizes, participants will only be eligible for an age category prize in the age category they enter. Corresponding numerical age category tags must be worn on the front and back of their club vest. Participants may enter the age category corresponding to their chronological age or any younger category down to senior.
- Athletes competing for a category prize must wear age category tags (on the front and the back).
   No swopping of race numbers or chips as these are linked to your names and finishing time and may result in disqualification.
- 11. Juniors must provide proof of age to qualify for prize money.12. All traffic officers and marshals must be obeyed.

- 13. Proof of age is required for category prizes.

  14. The race organisers reserve the right to accept or reject any entry.

  15. Foreign athletes must comply with IAAF rule 4.2 and all relevant race and domestic rules. The athletes must be able to produce the letter from his/her federation permitting participation on race day.

  16. Kilometre markers will be placed at each kilometre mark.
- 17. Refreshments stations will be situated approximately every 3km.18. Medals will be handed to all finishers.
- 19. Results will be available on www.topevents.co.za and www.safarihalfmarathon.co.za 20. Prize-Giving will take place between 11h00 and 11h30.
- 21. The club house and school toilets will be closed on race day, please make use of the portable toilets provided.
- 22. No ambush marketing.
- 23. There will be a tog bag facility for use at athlete's own risk. Cell phones, money & jewellery are not to be left in tog bags. No bag tag, no bag. 24. FREE parking will be available at the following venues: Huguenot Junior School & Boland Rugby Grounds. 25. For information regarding accommodation please contact the Wellington Tourism Bureau on 021 873 4604 26. A secure area for the safe keeping of tog bags is available in the school hall. Bags must be collected by 12pm on race day.
