- RACE DAY: Entries will be taken on race day from 06h00 at the Mamre Primary School in the hall.

RACE RULES:

- The Mamre 21km is open to all licenced and non-licenced runners of 16 years and older on Race day.
- 2019. Licence numbers must be worn on the front and the back of the vest.
- Temporary licences will be available at registration, R60 for seniors and juniors. When registering, participants must complete and hand in the tear off strip from the number in order to be eligible to compete.
- Temporary licenced participants are eligible for age category prizes provided they enter the relevant age group, wear the appropriate age tags and provide proof of age.
- Unlicensed runners must wear plain clothes (no advertising permitted) and the temporary licence on the front of the vest.
- Free entry to all Great Grandmasters (70+)-proof of age may be required. Unlicensed 70+ is R60
- No personal seconding will be permitted except at official refreshments stations.
- No Race numbers will be issued. All registered athletes must wear two valid licence numbers. Unregistered participants must purchase a Temporary Licence which must be worn on the front of the vest.
- Do not litter. Dispose of sachets and cups responsibly by using the boxes provided or carrying them to the finish.

 Report offenders to the referees. #RunGreen #RunClean.
- Detailed rules are available on www.wpa.org.za or on request from the organisers or WPA office.
- The use of music players with headphones is not allowed and may result in disqualification.
- Ensure that your club name and licence number are filled in on your entry card.
- In addition to overall (Open) prizes, participants will only be eligible for an age category prize in the age category they enter. Corresponding numerical age category tags must be worn (40, 50, 60.etc.) on the front and back of their club vest. Participants may enter the age category corresponding to their chronological age or any younger category down to senior.
- Wheelchair athletes must please contact the organisers timeously to discuss arrangements for their participation.
- Licenced runners must wear club colours to qualify for team prizes and participate with a permanent licence.
- No swopping of WPA licence numbers as the number is linked to your name and finishing time. Swopping or lending licence numbers could result in disqualification.
- Juniors (born from 2000 onwards) wearing a junior or senior licence must wear an age *category* tag to qualify for age group prizes. Juniors will count towards the Open team prizes.
- Runners must give proof of their age at the request of the Race Referee (Original ID/Birth Certificate/ Permanent residence Permit for category prizes.
- Entry race cards must be in athletes possession at all times during the race, and handed in at the results board at the Finish.
- All traffic officers and marshals must be obeyed.
- The race organisers reserve the right to accept or reject any entry.

- Foreign athletes must comply with IAAF rule 4.2 and all relevant race and domestic rules. The athletes must be able to produce the letter from his/her federation permitting participation on race day.
- The entry fee is non-refundable.
- Kilometre markers will be placed at each kilometre mark
- Refreshments stations will be situated approximately every 3km.
- The first 10 men & women will receive gold medals, 11 –100 men & women will receive silver medals 101-1000 will receive bronze medals.
- There will be a tog bag facility available. Organisers and Mamre Athletic Club members will not be held responsible for loss or damages. Do not leave valuables or cash in your bag.
- Toilets will be available.
- Parking is available on the school grounds.

DIRECTIONS TO MAMRE VIA N7 AND R27



ROUTE A (via N7)

- 1. Follow N7 until Philadelphia/ Stellenbosch/ Atlantis turn-off (intersection) about 1km passed the ENGEN SWARTLAND 1-STOP.
- 2. Turn LEFT and continue until T-junction (Tree Lane- R304)(Atlantis)
- 3. Turn RIGHT, continue until STOP (+/- 6.5km), go over to the next STOP (+/- 200m further)

 NB!! Landmark: Saxonwold Supermarket and road connection to/from Malmesbury on right hand side of the stop.
- 4. Continue with tree lane over a third stop (Witsand informal Settlement) and continue over 2 traffic circles to the first 4way stop.
- 5. At 4way stop turn RIGHT and continue through Atlantis over four 4way stops. NB!! LANDMARK: K F C right hand side of 1st 4way stop.
- 6. Follow 21km road signs past Silverstream road and LEFT into Main road to Mamre.
- 7. Follow marshals instructions into entry area.

ROUTE B (via WEST COAST ROAD/R27)

- 1. Follow R27 past the Melkbos traffic lights until Atlantis/Mamre turn-off 7km/14km sign.
- 2. Turn RIGHT and continue with road past Atlantis (on your Right) until T-junction and STOP sign.
- 3. Turn LEFT at T-junction, follow nrs 6 and 7 above.
