Rules: The race is run in accordance with the rules of ASA and AGN:

1. Athletes who do not adhere to the rules will be disqualified.
2. Registered Athletes must wear the 2024 license number, front and back, if issued with a race number, this must be worn on the front of vests.
3. All licensed Athletes competing for category prizes must wear numeric category tags, clearly visible on the front and back of their vests. Proof of age for prize winners may be required to be presented to referees before receiving the prize. Prizes will be withheld until confirmed. Race numbers must not cover the logos on the license.
4. Walkers competing for prize money must wear WALKER/W tags on the front and back of their vests.
5. Minimum age for race entries: **5km:** 9 years; **10km:** 14 years and **21km:** 16 years
6. No seconding is allowed.
7. Temporary licensed Athletes are eligible for open and category prizes, provided they have the age category tag clearly visible on the front and back of their vests.
8. All traffic officers and officials instructions to be obeyed.
9. Time limit is 3 hours 30 minutes, for ALL Athletes. Last runner/walker must finish by 09h30.
10. No blade, cyclist, or mechanically operated device allowed in the race.
11. All Athletes participate solely at their own risk and the organisers and sponsors will not be held responsible for any injury, illness, accidents or theft occurring during, or as a result of the race.
12. No i-Pods or listening devices are allowed on the race.

Late Entries can be made from Wednesday, 13th, until before the race, on Saturday, 16th March, at the Vodashop, in Irene Village Mall - 012 662 4297.

Entries can be collected at the Vodashop from Wednesday, 13th until Friday, 15th March, from 15h00-18h00 or on Saturday, before the race, from 04h30-06h00.
