GENERAL RACE INFORMATION - NMB UITENHAGE HUMAN RIGHTS RACE

- 1. Races will start at 06h30 (21.1km), 07h00 (10km) and 07h15 (5km) respectively.
- 2. The start is at the Despatch Rugby Club, Botha Street, Despatch.
- 3. Organised in accordance with the rules and regulations of ASA and EPA. All athletes indemnify the National, Provincial and Regional bodies, sponsors and organizers against all and any actions of whatsoever nature.
- 4. Athletes must display the official race number on the front of the vest/tshirt and 2024 licence number on the front and back of the vest.
- 5. Race numbers contains a chip and must not be bent or folded.
- Athletes who are not licensed members of a club affiliated to ASA must purchase a temporary license to be worn on the back of vest or plain coloured T-shirt, with the official race number on the front of the vest/T-shirt.
- 7. Age category tags must be worn on front and back of your vest if you wish to qualify for category prizes. Athletes may be requested to provide proof of age on race day.
- 8. Athletes must be at least 16 years or older for the 21.1km, 14 years or older for the 10km and 9 years or older for the 5km.
- Registered athletes are covered by a group personal insurance scheme. Temporary licenced athletes have no cover and are urged to join an affiliated club.
- 10. The race committee reserves the right to accept or reject any entry.
- Club Gazebo's are welcome, however it is a licenced premises so no alcohol may be brought into the stadium.
- 12. Entries may be handed in at Brian Bands, The Footballer, Sportsmans Warehouse or UD Sports in Uitenhage. The closing date for pre-entries will be at 14h00 on Wednesday 13 March 2024. Online entries are available on www.webtickets.co.za until Tuesday 12 March 2024
- 13. Collection of race numbers (pre-entries) and late entries will be accepted at the EP Athletics office, Westbourne Oval, Westbourne Road between 14h00 and 18h00 on Friday 15 March 2024.
- 14. Race numbers can be collected on the morning of the event.
- 15. There will be NO late entries on the morning of the event for the 21.1km or 10km event.
- 16. The no seconding rule will apply for the 10km. Personal seconding on the 21.1km route at waterstations only, stand and hand rule applies.
- 17. All traffic Officials and marshalls must be obeyed.
- 18. The cut off time for the 21.1km is at 10h00 and 08h40 for the 10km.
- 19. There will be sufficient refreshment stations on the route and one refreshment station on the 5km route. Refuse bins will be provided along the route. Please discard used water sachets into or near to these bins. Littering may lead to disqualification.
- 20. Full results will be available on www.epathletics.co.za.
- 21. The wearing of earphones or headsets is not permitted due to safety reasons and will lead to disqualification.
- 22. A finishers token will be awarded to all finishers.
