Race rules & information

- Number & T-shirt Collection: Friday, 16 Feb from 13:00 - 19:00 and on the day from 04:00 to 05:00. **NB: No collection on Race Day.**
- Current license number to be worn on the front and back of vest. Tog bag facility will be provided at own risk.
- The race will be run in accordance with the rules of WA, ASA and KZNA, and all participants to abide by these rules.
- All foreign athletes must comply with with WA Rules 4.2, 22.1 and 142, and ASA RULE 9.
- Refreshment stations will be provided along the route and no personal seconding will be permitted.
- Marshals, Traffic Officials and Technical Officials must be obeyed.
- Age Restriction: participants must be 19 years and older for 21km, 14 years and older for 10km and 9 years and older for 5km.
- Proof of age will be required for age category winners.
- ASA/KZNA approved age category tags must be worn on top front and back of vest/crop top to be eligible for age category prizes.
- Walkers: KZNA/ASA approved "W" walker tags must be worn on top front and back of vest/crop top to be eligible for prizes.
- Junior athletes, 19 years or younger, on 13 December, in the year of the competition must wear "y" on the upper front and back of vest/crop top in order to be eligible for prizes and must provide proof of age on race day.
- ASA LICENCE NUMBERS: May NOT replace license numbers with Competition/Race Numbers/Stickers under any circumstances. Where a Competition/Race number is used, it must be placed so that the ASA License Sponsor and ASA Province/Year remains visible above the Competition/Race number. The License numerals may be covered. Athletes who fail to adhere to this rule may be disqualified.
- TEMPORARY LICENCES: Temporary licensed athletes are not covered by a national insurance policy. Refer ASA Rule 25.6.15.
- The rule must adhere to WA and ASA Rules or ASA Council Meeting to get approval for the change.
- Unregistered athletes running with Temporary Licenses must run in neutral colours and adhere to WA and ASA Rules.
- Holders of Temporary Licences will be eligible for individual prizes and may claim age category prizes in keeping with WA and ASA Rules and rule 25.5.13.
