- 2 Temporary licences will be available at registration. When registering, participants must complete and hand in the tear-off strip from the number in order to be eligible
- Do not litter. Dispose of sachets and cups responsibly by using the boxes provided or carry them to the finish. Report offenders to the referee. #RunClean 3.

- 5 Cut-off times: 2hrs from the start of the race.
- 6. In addition to Overall (Open) prizes, participants will only be eligible for an age category prize in the age category they enter.
- Age category tags must be worn (front and back) and visible for the entire race to be eligible for any category prize.
- 8 Participants must be 14 years or older on the day of the race.
- Temporary licensed participants are eligible for age category prizes provided they enter the relevant age group, wear the appropriate age tags and provide proof of age.
- 10. Juniors (born from 2000 onwards) wearing a junior or senior license must display category tags "J" to qualify for age group prizes. Juniors only count for the junior team prize and do not count for the Senior team.
- No personal seconding will be permitted except at official refreshment stations.
- 12. Club colours must be worn to qualify for team prizes.
- Licenced athletes should wear club colours and must display a valid 2019 licence number on the front and back of their vest. 13
- 14. Unlicenced athletes must run in clothing without advertising and must purchase a temporary licence that must be worn on the chest.
- 15. Entry cards must be carried for the duration of the race and handed in at the results board at the Finish. Participants without an entry card may be disqualified.
- 16 Prize giving starts at 08h15.
- 17. No Race numbers will be issued. All registered athletes must wear two valid licence numbers. Unregistered participants must purchase a Temporary Licence which must be worn on the front of the vest
- 18. The use of I music players with headphones is not allowed and may result in disqualification.
- Wheelchair athletes must please contact the organisers timeously to discuss arrangements for their participation. 19.
