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## Event Rules:

1. One race number (bib) will be issued. Registered athletes must wear their ASA licences on the front and back of their vest. The race number must be worn on the front of the vest, partially covering the ASA licence, so that the ASA licence sponsor remains visible. Unlicensed athletes must wear a temp licence number on the back and race number on the front of the vest. Temporary licence holders, when registering, must complete and hand in the tear off strip from the number to be eligible to compete.
2. Temporary licensed athletes must run in clothing without advertising. Licensed athletes should wear club colours.
3. There are no age category prizes.
4. Participants must be 14 years or older on the day of the race.
5. Entry cards must be completed before the race, be in the athlete's possession during the race and handed in at the results board at the finish.
6. There will be no refreshment table on route. Athletes will receive a bottle of water prior to the start which must be carried for the duration of the race and handed in at the finish in exchange for a medal.
7. **PLEASE REFRAIN FROM LITTERING OR BE LIABLE FOR A FINE.**
8. The use of music players with headphones is not allowed and may result in disqualification.
9. The route is not wheelchair friendly.
10. Pets will not be allowed.
11. This race is run according to the rules of ASA and WPA. Detailed rules are available on [www.wpa.org.za](http://www.wpa.org.za) or on request from the WPA office.
