Entry Rules

- 1. The race is run according to the rules of ASA and WPA.
- 2. Participants must be 14 years of age or older on race day.
- Race numbers (bibs) will not be issued. All registered athletes must wear two valid licence numbers.
 Unregistered participants must purchase a Temporary Licence which must be worn on the front of the vest.
- Temporary licence holders, when registering, must complete and hand in the tear off strip from the number in order to be eligible to compete.
- Licenced athletes should wear club colours. Full club colours must be worn to qualify for team prizes.Temporary licenced athletes must run in clothing without advertising.
- Age category tags must be worn (front and back) and visible for the entire race to be eligible for any age category prize including Juniors.
- 7. In 2024 Juniors are defined as anyone born in 2005 or later. (Under the age of 20 at year end).
- Entry cards must be in the athlete's possession during the race and handed in at the results board at the Finish.
- 9. Cut-off time is 09h00 and Prize-giving is at 09h00
- Do not litter. Dispose of sachets and cups responsibly by using the boxes provided or carrying them to the Finish. Report offenders to the referees. #RunClean.
- 11. There will be two water stations at 3km and 7km as well as water & Coca-Cola at the finish.
- 12. The use of music players with headphones is not allowed and may result in disqualification.

- Wheelchair athletes must please contact the organisers timeously to discuss arrangements for their participation.

- 5. Turn right onto Balvenie Ave
- 6. Turn left onto Neptune St
- Turn left onto Galaxy Way

From N1 Paarl

- 1. Follow N1 to Giel Basson Dr/M12 towards Cape Town.
- 2. Take exit 16 from N1
- Turn left onto Giel Basson Dr/M12
- Turn right onto Frans Conradie Dr/M25
- 5. Turn left at the 1st cross street onto Hugo St
- Continue onto Halt Rd
- Continue straight to stay on Halt Rd
- 8. Turn right onto Grand Vue Ave
- 9. Turn left onto Neptune St
- Turn right onto Galaxy Way
