RACE RULES:

- 1 - This race is run according to the rules laid down by the WA, ASA, and KZNA and all entrants must abide by these rules.
- 2 - The minimum age limit of an entrant for the 21.1km is 16 years and older, the 10km is 14 years and older, and the 5km is 9 years and older.
- 3 - Current licenses, age category and walker tags must be clearly worn on the front and back of the vest/crop top.
- 4 - The race number must be placed so that the ASA License Sponsor, Province and year remains visible above the race number. The license numerals may be covered. Athletes who fail to adhere to this rule may be disqualified (ASA rule 26.1.7).
- 5 - Junior athletes must be 19 years or younger on 31 December in the year of the competition, must wear a "J" on the upper front and back of the vest/croptop in order to be eligible for prizes, must provide proof of age on race day.
- 6 - Temporary license (if purchased) must be worn on the back of the vest / crop top with the race number worn on the front.
- 7 - Temporary licensed athletes are not covered by National Insurance Policy. Refer to ASA Rule 25.6.15
- 8 - Unregistered athletes running with temporary licenses must run in neutral colours and adhere to WA and ASA advertising regulations.
- 9 - Holders of temporary licenses will be eligible for individual prizes and may claim age category prizes in keeping with WA and ASA rule 25.6.13.
- 10 - All Foreign Athletes must comply with WA CR 1.7, TR 4.1 and 4.2 together with and ASA Rule 9
- 11 - Club colours must be worn.
- 12 - Proof of age **MUST BE PRODUCED** if entrant qualifies for a prize category.
- 13 - Race entry fees are not refundable.
- 14 - Refreshment tables will be provided. Personal seconding is not permitted. No pacing is permitted.
- 15 - Marshals, technical officials and traffic officials must be obeyed.
- 16 - All entrants participate at their own risk. Organisers and sponsors will not be held responsible for any loss or injury during or as a result of the race, property loss or damage on the course or in the changing area.
- 17 - Tog bag facility will be provided but at owner's risk.
- 18 - No littering rule (ASA rule 28.4 & 28.5 and WA rules CR 18.5, TR 7.2 and TR 7.3).
- 19 - For safety reasons the use of personal music players or other devices with headphones is not allowed. Any person using such a device shall not be eligible for individual or team prizes and may be disqualified without a warning. ASA Rule 34.10.6
- 20 - 3 Hour cut off for 21.1km. Any 21.1km athlete arriving at the 10km marker after 1 hour 35min, will be diverted to the 10km finish.
- 21 - Prize giving will commence at 08:30am.
