42.2KM & 21.1KM DISPOSABLE TIMING CHIPS:

Your timing chip will be placed on your race number. The race number must be worn on the front of your vest and visible at the finish line. There is a foam strip on the back of the race number. Please do not remove the timing chip and foam strip from the race number. Doing so will result in NO finish time. For safety and timing purposes, ONLY the person assigned to this race number may use it.

PRIZE GIVING & PRIZE MONEY:

Prize giving for the half marathon will take place at the Eikestad Primary School and start between 09:30 and 10:00.

Prize giving for the marathon will take place at the Eikestad Primary School and start between 11.30 and 12:00.

Category winners will receive their prizes followed by the lucky draws. Participants must be present with their race number to claim prizes in the lucky draw.

PERMANENT NUMBERS:

The following awards will be handed out as runners who qualify for these prizes finish the race:

- Permanent numbers for a 10th run; Unique "Wingerdstompie" trophies after 15 completed runs and Double laurel permanent numbers after 20 completed runs.
- Entrants who have completed 9 Winelands marathons and will qualify for a permanent number, must please indicate as such on the entry form.

The following awards will be awarded at prizegiving:

• Permanent numbers for winning one of the categories (open, 40-49, 50-59, 60-69, 70+) for a 3rd time, Unique "Wynvat" trophies after 25 completed runs, Triple laurel permanent numbers after 30 completed runs and a special unique trophy after 40 completed runs."

5KM FUN RUN:

The fun run is an open event for licensed and unlicensed athletes. Children under 9 years must be accompanied by a parent or guardian. The start will be at 06:30 at Eikestad Primary School. For safety reasons young competitors are requested to start near the back. Entries at R20.00 each are taken on the morning of the run from 05:00. The time limit is 1 hour and all finishers will receive a medal. No dogs allowed.

RACE RULES

- 1. The Sportsmans Warehouse Winelands Marathon is run in accordance with the rules of ASA and WPA.
- 2. The Sportsmans Warehouse Winelands Marathon and Half Marathon are open to all licensed and non-licensed runners of 20 years and older for the marathon and 16 years and older for the half marathon on race day.
- 3. One race number (bib) will be issued. Registered athletes must wear their ASA licenses on front and back of their vest. The race number must be worn on the front of the vest, partially covering the ASA license, so that the ASA license sponsor remains visible. Temporary licensed runners must wear the race number on the front of their vest and the temporary license on the back.
- 4. Temporary licenses are available at R70 for the 42.2km and R60 for the 21.1km.
- 5. Temporary licensed participants are eligible for age category prizes provided they enter the relevant age group, wear the appropriate age tags and provide proof of age.
- 6. Unlicensed runners must wear plain clothes (no advertising permitted). Licensed athletes to wear club colours.
- 7. Personal seconding is not permitted. Private vehicles are requested not to follow the athletes on the route.
- 8. In addition to overall (Open) prizes, participants will only be eligible for an age category prize in the age category they enter. Corresponding numerical age category tags must be worn on the front and back of their club vest. Participants may enter the age category corresponding to their chronological age or any younger category down to senior.
- 9. Proof of age is required for category prizes.
- 10. No swopping of race numbers as the race number is linked to your name and finishing time and may result in your disqualification.
- 11. Each race distance has a different race number range and colour with your data captured electronically. Do not transfer between races without notifying the race organisers.
- 12. All traffic officers and marshals must be obeyed.
- 13. The race organisers reserve the right to accept or reject any entry.
- 14. Foreign athletes must comply with IAAF rule 4.2 and all relevant race and domestic rules. The athletes must be able to produce the letter from his/her federation permitting participation on race day.
- 15. All entry fees are non-refundable.
- 16. Kilometre markers will be placed at each kilometre mark.
- 17. Medals will be handed to all finishers.
- 18. There will be tog bag facilities. Bags dropped off at runners' own risk and must be collected by 13h00 on race day.
- 19. Toilets will be available at the start and finish.
- 20. The time limit will be 6hrs for the marathon and 3½hrs for the half marathon.
- 21. Results will be available at www.finishtime.co.za , www.wpa.org.za and at www.topevents.co.za .
- 22. The use of music players with headphones is not allowed and may result in disqualification.
- 23. Detailed rules are available on www.wpa.org.za or on request from the organisers or the WPA office.
- 24. Wheelchair athletes to please contact the organisers timeously to make arrangements for their participation.
- 25. Temporary license holders when registering must complete and hand in the tear off strip from the number in order to be eligible to compete.
- 26. Age category tags must be worn (front and back) and visible for the entire race to be eligible for any age category prize.
- 27. Do not litter. Dispose of sachets and cups responsibly by using the boxes provided or carrying them to the finish. Report offenders to the referees. #RunClean.
- 28. We are trying to offset our environmental footprint and encourage runners to support the #ICarryMyOwn campaign. We will have water available at every water station for you to refill your cup/bottle but ONLY EVERY 2nd WATER TABLE WILL HAVE SACHETS.
- 29. Remember to #RunGreen #RunClean #IcarryMyOwn
- 30. Coke and water will be available at the finish

Parking

Parking is provided for 1200 vehicles at various venues in close proximity to the race venue. Security officials are on hand, and endeavour to keep the vehicles as safe as possible. However, runners making use of these parking facilities must ensure that they do not leave any valuable items or personal belongings in their vehicles.

Parking marshals are on hand to direct race participants to these parking venues. Please obey and respect these parking marshals. Their assistance is invaluable in ensuring that all participants arrive at the race venue on time. Runners are requested to provide adequate time en route to the race to ensure that they arrive on time for the start of the event.

Please note that the owners of vehicles that park illegally, will be held liable by the local Traffic Officials.
