TERMS, CONDITIONS, RULES & REGULATIONS

A. GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1. This is a road running race presented by Eskom Athletics Club Free State.
- This event takes place on Friday 30 August 2024. The event starts and finishes at Mediclinic, Meulen Street. Welkom. Free State.
- Route map(s) will be available at the entry points and start of the race. Distance markers will be placed on the route at 1km intervals.
- Road closure: Thursday 29 Aug and Friday 30 Aug 2024. Road closure according to the different routes and distances.
- Parking: Do not use the hospital parking area. There is sufficient parking space surrounding Mediclinic. Parking is at own risk.
- Sufficient amount toilets provided at Mediclinic and Welkom Square. No dressing rooms and shower facilities available.
- 7. No tog bag area and no club tents / gazebo space available.
- 8. No food stalls or refreshments available at event. Please support the businesses, service stations, and food courts in and around Welkom Square and Mediclinic.
- Different vehicles (3 leading cars) will be used for different races for assistance, control and safety. Medical support provided by ER24.
- 10. Water tables serve water sachets & cool drink in foam cups. Using of own water bottles allowed. Water bottles can be refilled at water points. No alcohol allowed at the race venue.
- 11. Medals are handed out to finishers upon completing the race at the finish line.
- 12. The event will comply with the Health and Safety regulations that may apply at the time of the event.
- 13. Sponsors listed for this event will not be interpreted as an entitlement for any participant to insist on free, discounted, or preferential treatment pertaining to the products and services offered by the sponsors.
- 14. Recommendation the wearing of reflective clothing, strip, bands and head lights.

B. RACE RULES

- 1. The race is held under the rules of WA, ASA and AFS.
- Athletes indemnify the national, provincial and regional bodies, sponsors and organisers of the race against any or all actions of whatsoever nature, whatever the same may arise out of their participation in the race.
- 3. Obey all marshals, traffic, authorities and rules. Breach of any regulations or requirement may lead to instant removal without appeal. The race organiser and safety officer have the final decision in this regard. Checkpoints on route.
- 4. All athletes participate at their own risk and acknowledge that they are medically fit and equipped to safely participate in this event. In case of an emergency report to the next water point on the route. At the finishing line an identified area will be demarcated for evacuation.
- 5. No vehicles allowed on the course. No seconding.
- No prams, blades, animals, cyclist or mechanically operated devices allowed. Wheelchairs allowed only in mile / 1.6km wheelchair disabled fun race.
- Medals will only be handed out to participants in possession of a fully completed entry ticket / race no.
- Littering is not allowed. Athletes are to dispose of any litter in appropriate bins. Intentional littering and littering in non-designated areas may lead to disqualification. AFS Clean run.
- Athletes will not be allowed to finish any distance race after the cut off time. No athletes will be allowed to start later than 5 minutes after the group start time.
- 10. This event offers a certified 5km route and results can be used to qualify for other events.
- Wearing of earphones, headsets and similar devices is not permitted Prescribed hearing aids are allowed.

C. TIMING AND RESULTS

- 1. Only the 5km Open race 18H30 will receive official results.
- Official race results wil be published within 48 hours.

D. ENTRIES - OPEN UNTIL THE DAY OF EVENT

- 1. Online entries and manual (individual and club / groups) entries will be accepted.
- Entries open on Friday 19 July 2024. Manual entries and collections at designated entry points will close on Friday 30 August 2024. Online entries (Entryninja) close on Tuesday 27 August 2024.
- Online entries can be collected at Virgin Active Cnr Meulen Street and Long Road, Welkom on 29 August 2024 (THURSDAY)
- 4. Entries will be open at the venue (Virgin Active) on the day of the event 30 August 2024.
- 5. A copy of your proof of payment will be required.
- 6. Strictly no refunds. Entries are not transferrable or deferrable unless otherwise announced.
- In the event that the race is cancelled due to reason outside the organisers control the event entry fees will not be refundable.
- 8. Incomplete or incorrectly completed entries and entries not fully paid will be rejected.
- The event organiser retains the right to refuse entry to persons under the influence of drugs or alcohol, who are disorderly, display inappropriate behaviour, vandalise property, or evade paying for admission.
- 10. Athletes who duplicate race numbers or participate without buying a race entry will be disqualified, dissociated from the event, and held liable for a double entry fee charge and / or disciplinary action.
- 11. Participants may contribute to the beneficiary / partner of choice: RACE IN HER HONOUR (SANBS); RACE OF JOY (CHARLOTTE MOLL HAVEN); RACE OF LOVE (CANSA). Additional donations are welcome even if you are not participating in the event.

E. LICENSES, RACE NUMBERS AND DRESS CODE

- ASA Licensed athletes must wear club colours and a valid 2024 licence number on the front and back of the vest. (Only 18h30 open 5km race applicable)
- International athletes are subjected to ASA rules and must be in posession of a clearance certificate and passport prior to entering / participation.
- The race number needs to be pinned and visible on the front of the vest. ASA rule apply and may not cover the ASA and sponsor logos on the ASA license. Age category tags are compulsory.
- 4. An athlete may not run with another athlete's race number. No transfer of race numbers
- All athletes must complete in full Race number, Temp no, Entry ticket and Entry form. Participants with incomplete information will not be considered for prizes
- Temporary Licenses must be pinned on the back of the vest. Clothing to be worn must be neutral of color. (Only 18h30 open 5km race applicable)
- No insurance coverage on temporary licenses no. (Only 18h30 OPEN 5km Race applicable.)
- Athletes are encouraged to wear the colours of their organization, business, school and to support the 2024 theme, "SPARKLING STAR CELEBRATION" in the colours of our beneficiaries

F. PRIZES & AWARDS

- All prize winners of the open 5km race will be requested to show proof of an identity (ID book, passport, drivers license or a birth certificate).
- Prize money to be paid at the event. No prize money will be paid if random drug testing was done on any race distance on the day of the event up to such time that ASA receive the results from the South African Institution for Drug Free Sport (SAIDFS).
- 3. Prize money and incentives will only be awarded to athletes with valid ASA 2024 licenses.
- Prize for Team, Club and School for the most entries Award for Best Dressed & Spirit announced on 31 Aug 2024 by SMS, Whatsapp, Email.
- Winners must be present for prize giving as soon as results are available: Mile / 1.6km (17h00), 5km Fun Run(18h45), 5km OPEN (19h15).
- 6. Prizes will be rewarded for the following:
 - 6.1. Medals are handed out to all finishers upon completing the race at the finish line.
 - 6.2. RACE OF LOVE (Mile /1.6km) Open Children, Masters & Wheelchair Races Top 3 Male & Female will receive an Anniversary Celebration award and lucky prizes.
 - 6.3. RACE OF JOY (Open 5km Fun Run) Women only: Top 3 will receive an Anniversary Celebration Award. The Top -10 finishers will receive lucky prizes
