GBS MUTUAL BANK MOUNTAIN DRIVE HALF MARATHON RULES AND RACE INFORMATION

1. ENTRIES

- 1.1 Half Marathon Online Registration: https://grahamstownsunsetrotary.org/gbs-mutual-bank-half-marathon-registration-form/
- 1.2 Participants must be 16 years and older on the day of the race.
- 1.3 Closing date for online registration is 21 August 2024 20h00.
- 1.4 Participants can still register and purchase temporary licences in person on 23 and 24 August 2024.

2. CONFIRMATION OF ENTRY

2.1 Entrants will receive an email confirming their entry, provided they enter a valid email address on their online registration form.

3. NUMBER COLLECTION

- 3.1 Number collection will take place on Friday, 23 August, between 16h00 and 18h00 and Saturday, 24 August, from 06h00 on Somerset Field, Graeme College.
- 3.2 Temporary licences will be provided to those who indicated they required one on their registration form and have paid the additional R50 temporary licence fee.

4. START

- 4.1 Start at 07h00 on 24 August 2023 on Somerset Field, Graeme College.
- 4.2 Entry fee is R200 per person until 1 July 2024 and R250 thereafter. Additional R50 for a temporary licence, if required.

5. ROUTE

5.1 Refreshment tables will be placed at regular intervals along the route and will supply water sachets and Coke. However, in order to LOWER YOUR CARBON (AND PLASTIC) FOOTPRINT, you are urged to run with a hydration pack/your own cup or make use of the recyclable cups and water dispensers at each water table. Our hope is to make this run 100% GREEN within the next 5 years. All cups / sachets must be discarded into the bins before the last bin provided which will be approximately 500m past the water station. Any runner littering outside this area will be disqualified.

5.2 Distance markers indicate the kilometres to be completed.

6. FINISH

- 6.1 All races will finish on Somerset Field, Graeme College.
- 6.2 Final cut-off at 11h00. Time Limit of 4 hours. Prizegiving will take place at 11h15.
- 6.3 Race officials will enforce the cut-off times.

6.4 Parking is available at the finish. Security is available, but vehicles are parked at the owner's risk. Between 06h30 and 11h00, vehicles will not be allowed through the Selbourne Road entrance and access to Somerset Field via the Hostel gate will be limited. Please use the swimming pool gate instead.

7. PRIZEGIVING

- 7.1 Spot prize winners must be present at the prizegiving ceremony to receive their prize.
- 7.2 Recipients of cash prizes must be in their club colours (tracksuits/running apparel). They will receive an acknowledgement of their prize and must provide the organizer with their bank details to receive an EFT of their prize money. Prizes will be paid out within 48 hours.
- 7.3 Prize winners may be requested to provide proof of age.

8. RESULTS

8.1 All results will be available on our website.



9. RACE RULES

- 9.1 The Half Marathon will be run on 24 August 2024 under the auspices of Albany Runners and according to the rules of ASA and Eastern Province Athletics.
- 9.2 Registered athletes are covered by a group personal accident insurance scheme. Details may be obtained from your club/province. Temporary licensed participants are therefore urged to join an affiliated athletics club. Details obtainable from the EPA Office phone 041 374 2818. Runners using temporary licenses shall produce proof of age on race day to qualify for prizes.
- 9.3 Competitors must run in club colours with a 2024 licence number or a temporary number displayed on their vests. Temporary licences are available on registration provided you requested one on entry.
- 9.4 The official event race number must be worn on the front and your club or temporary licence number on the back of your garment.
- 9.5 Age category tags must be worn on the runner's front and back in a visible position to qualify for age category prizes.
- 9.6 Category groups are as follows: Open, 35-39, 40-49, 50-59, 60+, Junior
- 9.7 All competitors must abide by the rules, regulations and instructions given by officials. Unless otherwise directed, all runners are to keep on the right-hand side of the road. Failure to obey the officials can result in disqualification and banning from future entry to the GBS Mutual Bank Mountain Drive Half Marathon.
- 9.8 Personal seconding rules apply and wearing of earphones will lead to disqualification.
- 9.9 The entry fee is non-refundable. If the event is cancelled for reasons beyond our control entry fees will be donated to the Miles for Meals projects for 2024-2025.

- 6.2 Final cut-off 18h00 at finish. Time Limit of 2 hours.
- 6.3 Parking is available at the finish. Security is available, but vehicles are parked at the owner's risk.
