RACE RULES

All Athletes:

• All Athletes must be amateurs as defined under Athletics South Africa rules and not under the stipulated ages as indicated • All entrants will participate under the rules of AGN and ASA and it is the athlete's responsibility to be familiar with the rules • Age restrictions: Minimum age of 14 years on the day of the race for the 10km. Minimum age of 18 years on the day of the race for the 33km, and 16 years on the day of the race for 21.1km • Marshals and Traffic Officers must be obeyed at all times – failure to comply with their instructions may lead to immediate disqualification • No seconding will be allowed • No blade, cyclist or mechanically operated device allowed in the race • It is the participant's responsibility to ensure that he/she is medically fit and healthy to participate in any of the events • The race committee reserves the right to accept or reject any entry • Proof of age must be produced if requested by the race referee • No iPods or any other audio devises are allowed. WA ruling (World Athletics) • No animals allowed • Medical support will be present on the race day.

Licensed Athletes:

• All entrants must be in the possession of a valid 2024 license no • Athletes must wear the official race number on front and the 2024 ASA license number on the front and back of the running vest – race number should not cover the logos on the license • Athletes competing for category prizes MUST wear official age category ID tags on the front and back of the running vest • Walkers competing for prize money must wear WALKER/W tags on the front and back of their vest.

Unlicensed Athletes:

- Non-registered athletes in the 33km, 21.1km & 10km must buy a temporary license at R60.00
- The temporary license must be worn on the back of the running vest and the race number on the front.
- The 33km is not recommended for wheelchair athletes

RACE INFORMATION

- PARKING FEES: ATHLETES ARE ENCOURAGED TO MAKE USE OF THE UNDERCOVER PARKING FACILITIES IN THE BROOKLYN MALL AT THE STANDARD FEE OF R10.00

ANDREW GREYLING

Andrew Greyling was a well-known former athlete and sport shop owner. At the age of 58 his life was tragically ended. Andrew Greyling and Marcel van't Slot opened Run-A-Way Sport in Lynnwood on 10 March 1994. On 4 December 1994 Marcel was tragically killed while out running. In January 1998, Stein Steinbach became a partner in Run-a-Way Sport and in December 2007 Stein and Werner Steinbach bought Andrew's shares.

Andrew was a versatile athlete who had received national colours for cross-country running and excelled at obstacle-racing. He came 3rd in the Two Oceans race in 1980 and on the track, Andrew finished 3rd in 1975, behind Ewald Bonzet (who set a SA record) He finished 3rd in the 3000 steeplechase at the 1977 SA Championships. In the marathon of 1975 Andrew finished 3rd at the SA Championships. His PB marathon time was 2:18:49
