5km Run/Walk

The 5km run/walk starts at 7h05. Cut off time is at 8h15. Race numbers must be attached to vest or T-shirts and be visible at all times. Competitors must be 9 years or older.

Medals

Gold medals to the first 5 men and ladies as well as the winners of the different age categories. Silver medals will be awarded to the next 150 athletes and bronze medals to all finishers within the cut-off for the 10km races. Medals to ALL finishers in the 5km event.

Follow Standford Road until you reach the Gelvandale Pool and Stadium. Parking access from Liebenberg road and field next to swimming pool in Beetlestone Road. Please obey parking marshal directions.









General race Information:

- 1. Organised in accordance with the rules and regulations of ASA and EPA.
- 2. Athletes must run in official club colours with 2024 licence numbers on the front and back of the vest and official race number on the front of the vest.
- 3. The race number contains a chip and should not be folded.
- 4. Athletes who are not licensed members of a club affiliated to ASA must purchase a temporary license to be worn on the back of vest or plain coloured T-shirt, with the official race number on the front of the vest/T-shirt.
- Age category tags must be worn on front and back of your vest if you wish to qualify for category prizes. Athletes may be requested to provide proof of age.
- 6. Wearing of earphones are not allowed and may lead to disqualification.
- 7. The race committee reserves the right to accept or reject any entry.
- 8. The Prize Giving will commence at 08h45.
- 9. Entries may be handed in at Brian Bands, The Footballer or UD Sport in Uitenhage. The closing date for pre-entries will be Wednesday 7 August 2024. Online entries are available on www.webtickets.co.za and online entries will close on Tuesday 6 August 2024. Full results will be posted on www.epathletics.co.za
- 10. Please support the anti-littering campaign and only discard sachets into or near bins provided along the route. Littering is an offence and may lead to disqualification.
- 11. Due to the public holiday on the Friday 9 August, collection of race numbers (pre-entries) and late entries will only be available at the race venue from 05h30 on the morning of the race. Entry fees are non-refundable.
- 12. The no seconding rule will apply. No private vehicles will be allowed on the route to second athletes.
- 13. There will be two refreshment stations on the 10km route and one refreshment station on the 5km route. Refuse bins will be provided along the route. Please discard used water sachets into or near to these bins.
- 14. A receipt slip may be required in the case of any discrepancy with pre-entries.
- 15. A tog bag storage facility will be available.
