Race Rules and Information:

- 1. Race held in accordance with WA, ASA and KZNA Rules.
- 2. The licence number may be covered with the competition issued number.
- 3. Both provincial licenses MUST be worn on the upper part of the vest/crop top (front and back).
- 4. Tog bag facilities will be provided use of them is at participant's own risk (race officials/organizers are not liable for loss of personal belongings).
- 5. All relevant age categories must be clearly visible.
- 6. No refunds.
- 7. No pacing permitted.
- 8. No seconding or vehicles will be allowed on the route.
- 9. Club kit to be worn.
- 10. Participants must obey Marshalls, traffic officials, and race officials.
- 11. All foreign/international athletes must comply with WA Rules CR1.7, TR4.1, TR4.2 and ASA Rule 9.
- 12. Regret no wheelchair athletes, blade, cyclist or mechanically operated device allowed in the races.
- 13. No animals are allowed in the races.
- 14. Dispose your water sachets in the recycling bins at the refreshment stations.
- 15. Refreshment statements (+3km) will provide Coke and water sachets. Do your bit to ensure that the race is litter free.
- 16. Only athletes who are of age 19 years and younger on the 31st December 2024 are eligible for a junior prize.
- 17. Proof of ID required for prize giving.
- 18. All prize winners must be present at the prize giving ceremony, failure to attend prize giving ceremony will result in forfeiture of prize money.
- 19. Should the race be selected by South African Institute for Drug-Free Sport (SAIDS) then prize money will only be provided upon receipt of the results.
- 20. Prize money will be paid via EFT within 24 hours of the race.

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
