RULES:

- All entrants participate at their own risk and indemnify the organisers and sponsors of any liability or claims howsoever arising.
- All licensed participants must wear a valid 2024 licence on the back & front of their vests, with their official race number on the front. Unlicensed runners must buy a temporary licence, to be worn on the back of their vest.
- Athletes may not run with another athlete's race number unless by prior arrangement with the race organizer.
- Entry forms are to be completed fully, including age, gender and next of kin.
- The race will take place under the rules of ASA, CGA and IAAF. All participants are to wear club colours or plain running gear if participating with a temporary licence - no advertising permitted.
- The race organiser retains the right to refuse entry to persons under the influence of drugs or alcohol, who are disorderly, or engage in inappropriate behavior.
- No seconding allowed.
- The minimum age for the 32km is 19 years.
- Age group ID tags to be worn visibly on front & back of vest. Proof of age to be produced to the organisers if requested.
- Foreign athletes must observe IAAF rule 4 paragraph 2 and are not eligible for team prizes.
- No pets will be allowed.
- No blades, cyclist, mechanically operated devices or wheelchairs allowed.
- Traffic Officers & Marshals are to be obeyed at all times.
 Marshals will be released after four & half hours. Cut off time for the race is 5 hours.
- No ear-pieces or iPods to be worn. These may be confiscated by referees.
- Littering is not allowed. All athletes are to dispose of litter in the bins provided.
- Objections to be lodged within 30 minutes after prizegiving with a non-refundable R500 deposit.
- Entry fees are non-refundable for any reason whatsoever.
