Rules in accordance with ASA & WPA

- The race is run according to the rules of ASA and WPA.
- Participants in the 10Km run must be 14 years of age or older on race day.
- Race numbers (bibs) will not be issued. All registered athletes must wear two valid licence numbers. Unregistered participants must purchase a Temporary Licence which must be worn on the front of the vest
- Temporary licence holders, before competing, must complete the bottom section of the temporary license with their emergency contact details.
- Licenced athletes should wear club colours. Temporary licenced athletes must run in clothing without advertising.
- Age category tags must be worn (front and back) and be visible for the entire race to be eligible for any age category prize, including Juniors.
- 7. A Junior is anyone under the age of 20 on 31st December of 2024 (i.e born in 2005 or later).
- 8. To qualify for team prizes, athletes

- must wear full club colours and participate with a permanent license.
- Entry cards must be in the athlete's possession during the race and handed in at the results board at the Finish.
- There will be two water stations with water sachets and Coca-Cola/ water at the Finish.
- Do not litter. Dispose of sachets and cups responsibly by using the boxes provided or carrying them to the Finish. Report offenders to the referees. #RunClean.
- 12. The use of music players with headphones are not allowed and may result in disqualification.
- Runners to obey traffic officers, race marshals, officials, and Safety Officers at all times.
- Detailed rules are available on www.wpa.org.za or on request from the organisers or the WPA office.
- Wheelchair athletes must please contact the organisers timeously to discuss arrangements for their participation.
