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Race Rules

- I. Race is under the auspices of the Elgin Athletic Club and run according to the rules of Boland Athletics and Athletics South Africa. Instructions of race officials must be complied with. Non-compliance may lead to disqualification.
- 2. Participants must be 16 years and older for the half marathon, and 12 years or older for the 10km trail run on race day. No age limit on participants of 5km.
- 3. All minors (under the age of 16) must be accompanied by a guardian and or adult at event.
- 4. 21.1 km athletes must wear a 2019 temporary licence on the back of the vest, with race number on the front.
- 5. In addition to Overall (Open) prizes, participants will only be eligible for an age category prize in the age category they enter. Athletes competing for a category prize must wear age category tags (on the front and back).
- 6. Proof of age is required for category prizes.
- 7. All athletes will have to wear race number provided.
- 8. No personal seconding will be premitted.
- 9. The race organisers reserve the right to accept or reject any entry.
- 10. Foreign atheletes must comply with IAAF Rule 4.2 and all relevant race and domestic rules. The athlete must be able to produce the letter from his/her federation permitting participation on race day.
- 11. The Entry Fee is non-refundable.
- 12. Runners will participate in this race at their own risk and agree to abide by the rules of the race.
- 13. Packhouse Challenge only is won by the team that cumulatively completes the most kilometres, i.e:
 - 10 athletes finishing the 21km = 210km
 - 5 athletes finishing the 10km = 50km
 - 20 athletes finishing the 5km = 100km
 - Total would be 360km (210km + 50km + 100km)
- 14. Only athletes directly associated to a company can be part of the Packhouse Challenge (i.e employed by company, spouses, children, or associated farmers and their direct families).
- 15. To qualify for the king of the mountain medal all 3 races needs to be completed before 12:00.
