# Race rules & information

#### **GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:**

- · The race will be run subject to WA, ASA & KZNA rules.
- · Online entries closing date is Wednesday Monday the 12th of February 2025.
- Temporary licenses (10km at R60 and 21.1km at R80 each will be available online and collected at registration.
- Temporary licenses to be worn on the back.
- · Race number to be worn at the front. Temporary licensed athletes are not covered by a national insurance
- · Policy, ASA Rule 25.6.15. Holders of temporary licenses will be eligible for individual prizes and may claim age category prizes in keeping with WA. ASA and KZNA rule 25.6.13.
- · Minimum age to enter 10km run 15 years old on race day.
- · Junior athletes must be 19 years or younger on the race day.
- · All entrants must ensure they are medically fit to run and fully understand that they run at their own risk and the organizers will not be held responsible for any injury or illness
- · Incurred during or as a result of the race, or for any property lost or damaged on the course or in the changing area.

#### **REQUIREMENTS:**

- · \*All participants must wear club colours and their KZNA-approved 2025 provincial licenses on the front and back of the club vest.
- New ASA/KZNA age category (60mm to 80mm) & walker tags must be worn on the front & back

- · Of the club vest and must be clearly visible to qualify for age
- Category prizes men /women: (35 -39), (40-49), (50-59), (60-69) and 70+
- \*Foreign athletes must comply with WA rules CR1.7, TR 4.1 and TR 4.2, ASA and KZNA Rule 9.
- · Category winners must be able to provide proof of age on requested.
- \*Walkers must wear ASA/KZNA new approved walker tags on the front & back of the club
- · Vest/crop top and must be clearly visible.
- · Athletes must obey marshalls, technical officials, and traffic officers.

#### IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- · Enter online: www.peaktiming.co.za. Credit card and EFT payment options are available.
- · Race packs collection at Richards Bay Sports Field Friday 14 February 2025 from 10h00 to 19h00 and Saturday 15 February from 0400 to 05h00.
- · No collection on the race day.
- · Tog bag facility available at owner's risk.
- · No seconding or vehicle will be allowed on the route
- · Club kit to be worn.
- No animals are allowed in the races
- · Dispose your water sachets in the recycling bins at the refreshments stations. Do your bit to ensure that the race is litter free.
- · Refreshment statements (+3km) will provide coke and water sachets.
- · Only athletes who are of age 19 years and younger on race day.
- · Proof of ID required for prize giving.
- · All prize winners must be present at the prize giving ceremony, failure to attend prize giving ceremony, will result in forfeiture of prize money.
- · Should the race be selected by South African instite for drugs - free sport (saids) then prize money will only be provided upon receipt of the
