**GENERAL RACE INFORMATION – 2025 MOTHERWELL FREEDOM RUN** 

- 1. 10km Race will start at 07h00 and the 5km event at 07h20.
- 2. The start is at the Raymond Mhlaba Sport Centre in Motherwell.
- 3. Organised in accordance with the rules and regulations of ASA and EPA. All athletes indemnify the National, Provincial and Regional bodies, sponsors and organizers against all and any actions of whatsoever nature.
- 4. Athletes must display the Official race number on the front of the vest/tshirt and 2025 licence number on the front and back of the vest/tshirt.
- 5. Athletes who are not licenced members of a club affiliated to ASA must purchase a temporary license to be worn on the back of vest or plain colored T-shirt, with the official race number on the front of the vest/T-shirt.
- 6. **Age category tags** must be worn on front and back of your vest if you wish to qualify for category prizes and be clearly visible on the vest/shirt. Athletes may be requested to provide proof of age on race day.
- 7. Athletes must be at least 14 years or older for the 10km and 9 years or older for the 5km.
- 8. Registered athletes are covered by a group personal insurance scheme. Temporary licenced athletes have no cover and are urged to join an affiliated club.
- 9. The race committee reserves the right to accept or reject any entry.
- 10. Entries may be handed in at Brian Bands, Sportsmans Warehouse or UD Sports in Uitenhage. The closing date for pre-entries will be at 14h00 on Wednesday 23 April 2025. Online entries are available on www.webtickets.co.za until 22h00 Tuesday 22 April 2024.
- 11. Collection of race numbers (pre-entries) and late entries will be accepted at the EP Athletics office, Westbourne Oval, Westbourne Road between 14h00 and 18h00 on Friday 25 April 2024.
- 12. Race numbers can be collected from 06h00 on the morning of the event. Late entries will be accepted between 06h00 and 06h45. Card facilities available.
- 13. 5km Entrants are requested to be at the venue before 07h00 to eliminate traffic issues.
- **14.** Race numbers contain a timing chip and must not be bent or folded.
- 15. The no seconding rule will apply for the 10km.
- 16. All traffic Officials and marshals must be obeyed.
- 17. The cut off time for the 10km is at 08h45.
- 18. There will be sufficient refreshment stations on the route. Refuse bins will be provided along the route. Please discard used water sachets into or near to these bins. Littering may lead to disqualification.
- 19. Full results will be available on www.epathletics.co.za.
- 20. The wearing of earphones or headsets is not permitted due to safety reasons and will lead to disqualification.
- 21. Medals will be awarded to all finishers and is part of the Legacy Project puzzle collection.
- 22. All prize monies will be paid via EFT.
- 23. Club Gazebo's are welcome, but the Prize giving will be held at 08h45 in the main hall. Athletes are requested to wear club clothing at Prize giving.
- 24. All pavements are out of bounds.
- 25. Please follow parking marshals' instructions.
