- 1.Start/Finish on premises of Makro Ggeberha, 735 Cape Road, Bridgemead.
- 2.Starting time: 10km-07h00/5km-07h10.
- 3. Race entry forms may be collected/handed in at Makro Ggeberha store, Brain Bands sports, UD sports and online Webtickets. Closing date for all pre-entries on Wednesday 02 July @ 16:00. Online entries closes on the evening of 01 July 2025.
- 4. Proof of payment may be required in the case of any discrepancy with pre-entries. 5.Collection of race numbers (pre-entries) and late entries will be accepted from 15h00 until 18h00 on Friday 04 July 2025 at Makro Ggeberha store and the morning of the race from 05h00 till 06h30 at the Makro Ggeberha store. All entries non-refundable
- 6.Cut of time: 100 minutes (08:40). Prize giving at 09:00am. All 10km runners must be in their club colours.
- 7. Lucky draw prizes available at prizegiving.
- 8. The minimum age for 10km is 14yrs on race day.
- 9. All runners run on the righthand side of the road, facing traffic. Unless otherwise directed by Marshall or Traffic.
- 10. All traffic officers & marshals shall be obeyed at all times.
- 11. Parking available at Makro.
- 12. Athletes must run in official club colours with 2025 licence numbers on the front and back of the vest. All prize winners must wear their official club colours during the prize presentation.
- 13. Unlicensed athletes in the 10km event must purchase a temporary licence to be worn on a plain vest or T-shirt.
