# **TERMS, CONDITIONS, RULES & REGULATIONS**

#### A. GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1. This is a road running race presented by Eskom Athletics Club Free State
- 2. This event take place on Saturday 23 Aug 2025. The event starts and finishes at Mediclinic, Meulen Street, Welkom, Free State.
- 3. Route map(s) will be available at the entry points and start of the race. Distance markers will be placed on the route at 1km intervals.
- 4. Road Closure: Saturday 23 Aug from 07:30 until 17:00. Road closure according to the different routes and distances.
- 5. Parking: Do not use the hospital parking area. There is sufficient parking space surrounding Mediclinic. Parking is at own risk.
- 6. Sufficient portable toilets provided at Mediclinic and Welkom Square. No dressing rooms and shower facilities available.
- 7. No tog bag area and no club tents / gazebo space available.
- 8. No food stalls or refreshments available at event. Please support the businesses, service stations, and food courts in and around Welkom Square and Mediclinic.
- 9. Different vehicles (3 leading cars) will be used for different races for assistance, control and safety. Medical support provided by ER24.
- 10. Water Tables serve Water sachets & Cold drinks Alcohol Prohibited at event
- 11. Medals are handed out to finishers upon completing the race at the finish line.
- 12. The event will comply with the Health and Safety regulations that may apply at the time of the event.
- 13. Sponsors listed for this event will not be interpreted as an entitlement for any participant to insist on free, discounted, or preferential treatment pertaining to the products and services offered by the sponsors.

#### **B. RACE RULES**

- 1. The race is held under the rules of ASA and AFS.
- 2. Athletes indemnify the national, provincial and regional bodies, sponsors and organisers of the race against any or all actions of whatsoever nature, whatever the same may arise out of their participation in the race.
- 3. Obey all marshal, traffic, authorities and rules. Breach of any regulations or requirements may lead to disqualification. The Technical Official / Delegate & Safety Officer has the final decision in this regard
- 4. All athletes participate at their own risk and acknowledge that they are medically fit and equipped to safely participate in this event. In case of an emergency report to the next water point on the route. At the finishing line an identified area will be demarcated for evacuation.
- 5. No vehicles allowed on the course. No seconding.
- 6. No prams, blades, animals, cyclist or mechanically operated devices allowed. Wheelchairs allowed only in mile / 1.6km wheelchair disabled fun race.
- 7. Medals will only be handed out to participants in possession of a fully completed entry ticket /
- 8. Littering is not allowed. Athletes are to dispose of any litter in appropriate bins. Intentional littering and littering in non-designated areas may lead to disqualification. AFS Clean run.
- 9. No Medals or prizes for finishes after the Cut-Off / Finish time No athletes will be allowed to start late
- 10. This event offers a ASA Certified 1.6 / mile, 5km and 10km route
- 11. Wearing of earphones, headsets and similar devices is not permitted Prescribed hearing aids are allowed.

#### C. TIMING AND RESULTS

- 1. Only the open 1.6km, open 5km, open 10km will receive official results
- 2. Official race results wil be published within 48 hours.
- 3. Results will be available at Link -results.finishtime.co.za

#### D. ENTRIES - VIRGIN ACTIVE WELKOM

- 1. Online entries and manual (individual and club / groups) entries will be accepted.
- 2. Online Entries open 7 July 2025 / Manual Entries open 19 Aug until 23 Aug 2025 Online entries close on Thu 20 Aug 2025 / Manual Entries Close Sat 23 Aug 2025
- 3. Online Entries can be collected at Virgin Active, Cnr Meulen Street and Long Road, Welkom on Fri 22 Aug (Cut off time 13:00 - 17:30) / Sat 23 Aug (08:30 Before 11:00)
- 4. Manual daily collected at (Virgin Active Welkom) "Open day of event" 23 Aug 2025
- 5. A copy of your proof of payment will be required.
- 6. Strictly no refunds. Entries are not transferrable or deferrable unless otherwise announced.
- 7. In the event that the race is cancelled due to reason outside the organisers control the event entry fees will not be refundable
- 8. Incomplete or incorrectly completed entries and entries not fully paid will be rejected.
- 9. The event organiser retains the right to refuse entry to persons under the influence of drugs or alcohol, who are disorderly, display inappropriate behaviour, vandalise property, or evade paying for admission.
- 10. Athletes who duplicate race numbers or participate without buying a race entry will be disqualified, dissociated from the event, and held liable for a double entry fee charge and /
- 11. Participants may contribute to the beneficiary / partner of choice: RACE IN HER HONOUR (SANBS); RACE OF JOY (CHARLOTTE MOLL HAVEN); RACE OF LOVE (CANSA). Additional donations are welcome even if you are not participating in the event.

#### E. LICENSES. RACE NUMBERS AND DRESS CODE

- 1. ASA Licensed athletes must wear club colours and a valid 2025 licence number on the front and back of the vest. (Only open 1.6km, open 5km and open 10km race applicable)
- 2. International athletes are subjected to ASA rules and must be in posession of a clearance certificate and passport prior to entering / participation.
- 3. The race number needs to be pinned and visible on the front of the vest. ASA rule apply and may not cover the ASA logos on the ASA license. Age category tags are compulsory.
- 4. An athlete may not run with another athlete's race number. No transfer of race numbers
- 5. All athletes have to complete in full Race number, Temp No, Entry ticket and Entry form. Participants with incomplete information will not be considered for prizes
- 6. Temporary Licenses have to be pinned on the back of the vest. Clothing to be worn must be neutral of colour. (Only open 5km, open 10km race applicable) No insurance coverage on temporary licenses no
