

Entries can be done at Brian Bands, Action Sports Summerstrand and UD Sports Uitenhage (Kariega). Entries at Sports shops close on Tuesday 7th October at 17H00.

- Registration and late entries at the Crusaders Club (St. Georges Cricket Stadium, Park Drive) on Friday the 10<sup>th of</sup> October 2025 from 16H00 to 19H00 and from 05H30 to 06H30 on Saturday morning at African Sky's.
- 2. PROOF OF PAYMENT MAY BE REQUESTED, please have it handy.
- Official ASA licence number to be worn on the front and back of the vest and the official race number placed over the licence number on the front of vest. The race number contains a chip and must under no circumstances be folded.
- 4. Registered athletes must run in their official Club colours.
- Non-registered runners will receive one Temporary licence number to be worn on the back of their running shirts. Race number on front of shirt. Temporary licence holders must wear a plain t-shirt or vest.
- 6. Age category identification must be clearly visible on the front and back of running vests to be eligible for prizes. Runners who are wearing temporary licences must wear a category age tag and present proof of age on race day to qualify for age-category prizes.
- 7. The race is run following ASA and EPA rules.
- 8. Cut-off time: 110min. No timing for the 5km event. Prizegiving will be at 09H15. Prize winners must be dressed in their club colours during the award presentation.
- 9 PLEASE DO NOT DRIVE ON THE ROUTE
- 10 Toilet facilities are available at Start/Finish
- 11. Participation in wheelchairs, prams, baby joggers or running with animals is not permitted.
- Disabled or blind runners are to be accompanied and may only make use of guides who have officially entered the event.
- 13. Tog bag storage facility and safe key storage are available at the start venue.
- 14. No personal seconding is allowed.
- 15. Refuse bins will be provided along the route. Please discard used water sachets in or near these bins.
- 16. Registered athletes are covered by a group personal accident insurance scheme. Details may be obtained from your club/province.
- Temporary licensed athletes are NOT covered by the ASA Insurance Scheme and are urged to join an affiliated club. Completion of the tear-off strip is compulsory.
- 18. Competitors must be 14 years of age on the race day for 10km & 9 years of age for 5km.
- Race Officials and Marshals are always to be obeyed. Run on the right-hand side of the road unless instructed otherwise by a Marshal.
- 20. The wearing of earphones or headsets is prohibited and will lead to disqualification.
- 21. No alcohol will be allowed to be brought onto the premises.
- 22. Food and refreshments will be on sale at the venue.
