- 1. The race is run in accordance with the rules of the ASA & AGN.
- 2. Athletes must wear the 2025 license numbers on the front and back of the vest.
- 3. Race numbers must be worn on the front of the vests and logos may not be covered on the license number.
- 4. Temporary licensed athletes to wear temporary license at the back of the vest.
- 5. Athletes competing for category prizes must wear age category tags on the front and back of vests. Proof of age for prize winners will be required and to be presented to referees be fore prize giving.
- 6. Walkers competing for prize money must wear WALKERIW tags on the front and back of vests.
- 7. Marshals, traffic officials and road rules must be obeyed at all times.
- 8. No iPods or listening devices are allowed No seconding is allowed.
- 9. Minimum age for participation: 14 years for 10km and 16 years for 21 km.
- 10. Medical support will be present on race day.
- 11. Cut off time is 3 hours for all events.
- 12. Parking is available but the race organisers will not be held responsible for any lost, stolen or damaged goods.
- 13. Distance markers every 1 km.
- 14. Tog bag area while available.
- 15. Ample space for gazebos.
- 16. Gazebos must be erected a day before the race.
- 17. Organizers indemnify themselves from any action or claim of whatever nature caused by the negligence of participants. Runners participate at own risk!!
- 18. International Foreign Athletes must purchase a temporary License Number and must produce clearance from their member federation if are contenders for Prizes
- 19. Great Grandmaster entry free.
