ROUTE INFORMATION

- Start at Velocity Sports Lab at the east side of the beach.
- Finish at Kronendal Primary School
- Route: Participants must stay on the left-hand side of the road at all times, unless instructed differently by the marshals and Traffic Officers.
- Distance markers will be placed at every kilometre. Please see route map on website (<u>www.chapmanspeakhalf.co.za</u>) for more information.
- 21.1 km This route is very scenic along the coastal road from Hout Bay to Noordhoek and back.
- **10km –** This route is very scenic along the coastal road from Hout Bay to the top of Chapmans Peak drive and back.
- The use of Chapman's Peak Drive is at your own risk. Please note there is the possibility of rock falls and the danger associated therewith.

RULES

- 1. The race is run in accordance with the rules of ASA and WPA. All participants must comply with the rules, regulations and instructions given by officials, marshals and traffic officials. Non-compliance may lead to disqualification. The race organiser reserves the right to accept / reject any entry received.
- 2. The athlete agrees to participate at their own risk and by their entry and participation fully indemnifies the organisers of the Chapman's Peak Half Marathon, Athletics South Africa, Western Province Athletics, City of Cape Town, Province, Entilini Concessions (Pty) Ltd, Sport Redefined, all official sponsors and partners, volunteer groups, medical suppliers, and any and all local authorities, from any direct or indirect loss or damage, however caused, arising from their participation in the event or related to the event, including pre-race and post-race activities.
- The Chapman's Peak Half Marathon takes place on Sunday 13 October 2019 - Hout Bay.
- Licenced athletes should wear club colours. Full club colours must be worn to qualify for team prizes. Temporary licenced athletes must run in clothing without advertising.
- 5. One race number (bib) will be issued. Registered athletes must wear their 2019 ASA licences on the front and back of their vest. The race number must be worn on the front of the vest, partially covering the ASA licence, so that the ASA licence sponsor remains visible. Temporary licenced runners must wear the race number on the front of their vest and the temporary licence on the back.

- 6. Temporary licence holders when registering must complete and hand in the tear off strip from the number in order to be eligible to compete.
- 7. No swapping of race numbers is permitted as the race number is linked to your name and finishing time. Any swapping may result in your disqualification.
- Categories & [Tags]: Age (40-49) [40] Age (50-59) [50] Age (60-69+) [60] Age (70+) [70] Junior Category [J] is less than 20 years old with the minimum age for each distance.
- 21.1km Minimum age 16 years on race day
- 10km Minimum age 14 years on race day Age category tags must be worn (front and back) and visible for the entire race to be eligible for any age category prize including Juniors.
- 9. Overall (Open) prizes, participants will only be eligible for an age category prize in the age category they enter. Corresponding numerical age category tags must be worn on the front and back of their club vest. Participants may enter the age category corresponding to their chronological age or any younger category down to senior
- **10.** Juniors (born in 2000 or later) wearing a senior or junior licence must display category tags "J", to qualify for age group prizes. Juniors will count towards Open team prizes.
- **11.** Runners must give proof of their age at the request of the Race Referee (Original ID / Birth Certificate / Permanent residence Permit)
- **12.** Temporary License Runners are eligible for an individual age category prizes provided they enter the relevant age group, wear the appropriate age tags on the front and back and provide proof of age.

- **13.** No personal seconding will be permitted, on Chapman's Peak Drive.
- **14.** Do not litter. Dispose of cups and other litter responsibly by using the bins provided. Report offenders to the referees. #RunGreen #RunClean #ICarryMyOwn.
- **15.** For safety reasons the use of personal music players during road races is not allowed and may result in disqualification.
- **16.** Detailed rules are available on www. wpa.org.za or on request from the organisers or the WPA office.
- **17.** Wheelchair athletes must please contact the organisers timeously to discuss arrangements for their participation.
- **18.** All entry fees are non-refundable and non-transferable under all circumstances, including, but not limited to, cancellation of the event or of the athlete's participation, or change in the date, nature, or format of the event. The event may be cancelled or changed due to severe weather or any other factors that may be deemed to threaten the safety of athletes, staff, or volunteers.
