EVENT T-SHIRTS

A free commemorative T-Shirt will be given to the first 400 online entries received for the 21km or 42.2km event. 10km and 5km athletes, as well as entries for the 21.1/42.2km beyond the first 400 may purchase a T-shirt, limited to the first 300 orders. T-shirts will be available at Race number collection (Point 7)

MEDALS

Medals will be available to the first 1500 finishers in the 42.2km, 800 for the 21.1km, 500 for the 10km and 300 in the 5km.

DIRECTIONS TO THE START

Drive up Old Cape Road or N2 towards St Albans and take the Baywest Boulevard turnoff. Start and finish will be at Baywest mall entrance 4.

PARKING

Parking is available at entrance 2, 3 and 4. Please obey parking marshals and enter and park as swiftly as possible. Start and finish will be at Baywest mall entrance 4. Parking tickets can be validated at Registration between 07h00 and 13h00.

ROUTE

The 42.2km will run up Cape Road past St Albans for 20km, followed by a 14km loop and finishing down Cape Rd back to Baywest Boulevard for the last 8km. The 21.1km runners will start with the 42.2km and turn at designated km mark. The 10km follows a route along Walker Drive and back. The 5km route is an offroad route on the Baywest Trail. The routes will be available on the EPA website.

Please take note of rules 17,18 and 19 regarding cut off times and personal seconding.

The organizers agree that all personal information requested on the form is for the use of the event only and will not be distributed to any third party.

GENERAL RACE INFORMATION

1. Organized in accordance with the rules and regulations of ASA and EPA. All athletes indemnify the National, Provincial and Regional bodies, sponsors and organizers against all and any actions of whatsoever nature.
2. 42.2km and 21.1km race will start at 05h30 from the Baywest Mall, Entrance 4. The 10km race will start at 05h45 and the 5km offroad run at 07h00.
3. **Athletes are requested to ensure that they access parking from the Baywest Mall Entrance 2 or 3.**
4. Online entries are available on www.webtickets.co.za and manual entries can be submitted to Brian Bands Sports in Cape Road, Sportsmans Warehouse and UD Sports in Uitenhage. **Closing date for entries will be 20h00 on Sunday 30 November 2025.**
5. A free commemorative T-Shirt will be given to the first 400 online entries received for the 21km or 42.2km event. 10km and 5km athletes, as well as entries for the 21.1/42.2km beyond the 400 may purchase a T-shirt. T-shirt sales close Sunday 30 November, but is limited to the first 300 sold. T-shirts will be available at Race number collection.
6. The race committee reserves the right to accept or reject any entry.
7. Collection of race numbers and late entries will be available from Baywest mall Centre court on Friday 5 December 2025 between 13h00 and 19h00 and from 04h30 on the morning of the event.
8. **LATE ENTRIES ON THE MORNING OF THE EVENT WILL BE AVAILABLE AT AN ADDITIONAL R30 ADMIN FEE.**
9. **Road race entries will be limited to 2,300; the 5km is capped at 300.**
10. Race numbers will contain a chip and must be clearly visible at the finish line.
11. Entry fees are non-refundable.
12. A receipt/proof of payment may be required in case of any discrepancy with pre-entries.
13. All traffic Officials and marshals must be obeyed.
14. The wearing of earphones or headsets is not permitted due to safety reasons and may lead to disqualification.
15. The minimum age is as follows: 42.2km – 20 years / 21.1km – 16 years / 10km – 14 years / 5km – 9 years.
16. The cut off time will be at 11h30 for the 42.2km (6 hours), 09h00 for the 21.1km (3 ½ hours) and 07h30 for the 10km.
17. **42.2km athletes that have not reached the 25km mark by 09h15 will be requested to abort the race.**
18. **No personal seconding (vehicle or bicycle) will be allowed for the first 18km of the marathon or last 8km.**
From 18km-30km seconding will be permitted within 100m of either side of the refreshment stations. Please consider the safety of athletes and travel swiftly from one point to another without stopping. Seconding may not be conducted from any vehicle; stationery or moving, and seconds may not run beside an athlete at the seconding stations.
19. **Personal seconding (vehicle or bicycle) will NOT be allowed on the 21.1km/10km route due to traffic congestion.**
20. EPA Championship medals will be awarded to the top 3 EPA licenced athletes in each age category for the marathon.
21. Age category tags must be visible on front and back of your vest if you wish to qualify for category prizes. Athletes may be requested to provide proof of age on race day.
22. Club gazebos are welcome in the designated area at Entrance 4. Please collect a parking disc at registration.
23. No alcohol may be brought onto the premises. Please support the food vendors and restaurants in the mall.
24. Athletes must wear 2025 licence numbers on the back and front of the vest/shirt, with the official race number on the front partially covering the licence number.
25. Athletes who are not licenced members of a club affiliated to ASA must purchase a temporary license to be worn on the back of a plain-colored vest/t-shirt. (not applicable for the 5km)
26. Prize giving and lucky draws will be held at 08h00 for the 10km, 09h30 for the 21.1km, and 11h00 for the 42.2km. Athletes must be dressed in their official club colours.
27. Lucky draws will be available to all participants at the 11h00 prize giving held at Centre court.
28. Prize monies will be paid via EFT within 7 days of the event
29. Registered athletes are covered by a group personal insurance scheme. Temporary licenced athletes have no cover and are urged to join an affiliated club.
30. Please obey parking marshals.
31. Athletes must run always facing traffic, unless instructed otherwise by a marshal.
32. Refuse bins will be placed up to 500m after the water stations. Please discard all litter (sachets/bottles/cups/other) into the bins provided and not beyond the designated points. **DO NOT THROW YOUR LITTER INTO THE BUSH. If need be, keep it with you until the next bin.**
33. Disposing litter outside the demarcated zone may result in disqualification.
