General race Information:Entry and race number collection information:

- Entries may be handed in at Brian Bands or Sportsmans Warehouse or online on www.webtickets.co.za. The closing date for all pre-entries will be 17h00 on Wednesday 5 February 2025.
- Collection of numbers and late entries will be available on Friday 7 February 2025 between 16h00 and 18h00 at the Cillie School JJ Engelbrecht sports fields, c/o Sydenham Road and Ambrose Street, North End, and from 05h30 on the morning of the event.

Licensing:

- Athletes must display the 2024/2025 licence numbers on the front and back of the vest/shirt and official race number placed over the licence number with ASA advertising visible. The race number contains a chip and must not be bent.
- Athletes who are not licensed members of a club affiliated to ASA must purchase a temporary license to be worn on the back of vest or plain colored T-shirt, with the official race number on the front of the vest/T-shirt. Temporary licenced athletes are not covered by ASA group insurance and are encouraged to join an athletics club.

Prize winners:

- Age category tags must be worn on front and back of your vest, clearly visible, if you wish to qualify for category prizes.
- Prize winners may be requested to provide proof of age.
- The Prize Giving will commence at 08h15. It is recommended that athletes dress in club kit when receiving prizes.

General:

- The wearing of earphones is not allowed and may lead to disqualification.
- The race committee reserves the right to accept or reject any entry.
- Full results will also be posted on www.epathletics.co.za.
- No Alcohol may be brought onto the premises.
- Entry fees are non-refundable.
- The no seconding rule will apply. No private vehicles will be allowed on the route to second athletes.
- There will be three refreshment stations on the 10km route and one refreshment station on the 5km route. Please support the Anti-littering campaign. Refuse bins will be provided along the route.
- DO NOT DROP YOUR SACHETS on the ground. USE THE BINS PROVIDED.** Littering is an offence and may lead to disqualification.
- Organised in accordance with the rules and regulations of ASA and EPA.
