- 7. Proof of age will be required in order to collect prize money.
- 8. Athletes to obey officials, Marshals, SAPS and Traffic Officers
- 9. Race abide by WA, ASA, and KwaZulu Natal Athletics rules and regulations
- 10. Junior Athletes must be 19 years and younger on 31 December in the year of competition, wear 'J' on the upper front and back of the vest/crop top in order to be eligible for prizes and must provide proof of age on the day.

- 12. Temporary licence athletes are not covered by national medical insurance policy,

- 13. Unregistered athletes running with Temporary licence must run in neutral colours and adhere to WA Adverting Regulations
- 14. Holders of temporary licences will be eligible for individual prizes and may claim age category prizes in keeping with WA and ASA Rules.
