REGISTRATION:

Pre entries are taken online from 01st of June until the 24th of September 2025 and late entries will also be taken on Saturday the 27th of September 2025 from 12:00pm to 17:00pm. No late entries will be taken on Sunday

HOW TO GET THERE:

Driving from KZN along R61 Main Road; cross Mtavuna Bridge and drive 7km to the Seaview Sports Field (31°02'57"S 30°07'57"E) opposite BP Garage where the parking will be reserved for athletics. For starting point you will drive from Seaview Sports Field through R61 main road and turn left at kwa-Bulala junction to DR08119 (Mtentu Beach Road), cross Ntlakwe Bridge, cross Mzamba Bridge and find the Starting Point at Mngungu Clinic gate (31°03'24"S 30°02'01"E) for 21.1km run.

Driving from Bizana through R61 main road, turn right at kwa-Bulala junction to DR08119 (Mtentu Beach Road), cross Ntlakwe Bridge, cross Mzamba Bridge and find the Starting Point at Mngungu Clinic gate (31°03'24"S 30°02'01"E) for 21.1km run.

Staring point for 10.0km run will be the same route, but; starting a kilometer away after passing kwa-Bulala junction (DR08119 and R61 Main Road) runing along R61 main road to our finishing point
